FEDERATIONS INVITED	The organizing member federation will invite all member federations in good standing who are able to nominate a team of at least 3 gymnasts . Federations who are unable to nominate a team may apply to join a mixed team. The LOC will gladly assist you to get in contact with other federations interested in nominating a mixed team.		
PLANNED COMPETITION FORMAT MAG	We offer a team competition for MAG with qualification and finals. For MAG , the competition consists of optional exercises on six apparatuses (only one vault). This competition is organized by a rotation of groups. A group comprises teams of up to 5 gymnasts entered by national federations or mixed teams consisting of individual gymnasts of different federations. Qualification: Not more than 4 gymnasts of each team compete on any single apparatus and the 3 highest scores are taken into account for the team total (5 – 4 – 3 system). Finals: The 6 teams having obtained the highest total scores in the qualification

	Please note that only teams meeting the minimum delegation size at and during the time of competition will be allowed to participate. If a team is not able to provide the required number of starters per apparatus, the team will be disqualified.			
AGE LIMITS	Age Limit for MAG: 18 years (born in 2000 or before) Age Limit for WAG: 16 years (born in 2002 or before)			
JUDGES AND JURIES	For MAG and WAG, the participating member federations must send a minimum of one qualified judge for each participating MAG team and one for each WAG team. All judges must have a current valid FIG brevet at the time of the event. Failure to provide judges as mentioned above at the time of the definitive registration will result in an LOC charge of 1,000 EUR to the federation concerned (non-refundable). This fine must be paid to the LOC until 17 January 2018. Depending on the number of participating teams and judges, the LOC will determine the number of Apparatus Juries (judges' panels).

TIE BREAKING RULES	 Qualification: In case of a tie in points at any place in qualification, the ranking will be determined by the following criteria: The team with the highest sum of the team apparatus counting scores obtained will prevail (i.e. the total of 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 highest apparatus team scores for men and the total of 3, 2, 1 highest apparatus team scores for women) If they remain tied the teams will share the same rank. Final: In case of a tie at any rank, the tie will not be broken. The prize money of the tied ranks will be added and divided by the number of ties.

ACCOMMODATION	The LOC will offer three different hotel categories, one of them being a fin class hotel (Cat.1; e.g. Best Western Plus), one middle-class (Cat.2; e. Hotel Europe) and one "lower-cost hotel" (Cat.3; e.g. Achat Hotel),.

	 All categories include: Accommodation in single/double room (double rooms can only be booked for two) Breakfast Banquet Free transportation from Stuttgart airport or railway station to the hotel and back/ free transportation from hotel to the competition venue and back (only if accommodation is booked via the LOC). 		
	The prices charged for the hotel rooms will not exceed the usual hotel rates. The Accommodation Form must be returned to the LOC by 17 January 2018 at the very latest. Hotel rooms are allocated on a "first come, first serve" basis. Please note that room rates may be higher for rooms booked after the accommodation deadline and that not all hotels might still be

	After the Definitive Registration you will get an invoice stating the accommodation costs which are due until 17 January 2018 . Registrations without timely payment of accommodation costs are considered invalid and will be cancelled.		
	Cancellation policy: The whole amount will be refunded for cancellations submitted before 17 January 2018. For any partial or total cancellation after 17 January 2018, no money will be refunded. If accommodation is booked via the accommodation form after the deadline, the amount is due immediately and no money is refunded in case of a cancellation.		
MEALS	All delegations have to pay for their own meals apart from breakfast, which is included in the accommodation price.		
FINAL BANQUET	A final banquet will be held on Sunday, 18 March 2018. Entrance is free for all delegation members.		
INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION	The members of the invited participating federations must pay for their international transportation.		
LOCAL TRANSPORTATION	Local transportation between Stuttgart airport/ train station and the LOC hotels and between the LOC hotels and the competition venue will be provided by the LOC for all delegation members.		

	However, local transportation free of charge will be provided only for delegations that have booked their accommodation via the LOC . Please note that if you need the invitation letter as an original with signature and stamp, we will send it via DHL express and you have to carry the cost of EUR 100. We can, of course, send you a copy via email for free if the meets the requirement of your country. 	
INSURANCE	The Host Federation, the LOC and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and the like. The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their delegation. Delegation members with insufficient insurance cover must inform the LOC in advance. The LOC will subsequently offer insurance at the Federation's charge as follows: 5 EUR per person/ per day.
