

Glasgow 2018 European Championships Accreditation System



As the Glasgow 2018 European Championships is a multi-sport event featuring Gymnastics, Cycling, Aquatics, Golf, Rowing and Triathlon, the implementation of a unified accreditation system is required to ensure consistency across sports and venues.

The main objective of G2018 Accreditation is to ensure a streamlined and a smooth as possible Accreditation procedure for all involved clients and participants.

With this in mind the goal is to keep the best level of consistency and maintain the look and feel of a multisport event in order for the Accreditation system to be functioning across all G2018 European Championships Sports & Venues.

Gymnastics as an inextricable part of this event is no exception and certain unifying elements that differ from the UEG Accreditation Directives had to be identified that relate to the Job titles and zones.

Job title identification

Most of the job titles that will be utilised under the category of Member Federation (delegation) match the UEG Accreditation directives and the differences are restricted to just the wording e.g. the "Gymnast" for the purposes of Glasgow 2018 European Championships Accreditation will be identified as "Athlete"

The table below summarises the titles that will be used in G2018 Accreditation with their UEG Accreditation directives equivalent

Access Privileges assignment and zones

In relation to access privileges for each job title the implementation of venue zoning takes once again into consideration the level of consistency across all sports and venues and meets the Gymnastics requirements. The differences are limited to only decreasing the number of active zones within the venue to 9 from 16 initially. This neither restricts nor compromises the operational role of each delegation member at Championships time, since the UEG existing zones have only been combined under the umbrella of the zoning system presented below.

The zone access entitlements and the accreditation privileges by Job title are part of the privilege matrix that will be made available to every Member Federation before the start of the Accreditation Application Process that starts in April 2018.

The rules for transferable access cards as stated in the UEG Accreditation Directives will still apply to the Glasgow 2018 European Championships, however Zone 3 (Warm-up Hall) is classified under Zone 1 and upgrade cards will be given for those who have permission to access this zone.

Transferable Access Cards to be used in conjunction with the primary accreditation card (the total number of transferable access cards for coaches may not exceed the total number of coaches per discipline)

Transferrable access cards for the Warm-up Halls and the Field of Play (FOP)

A certain number of Transferrable Access Cards are allocated to the MF. Such cards may only be used by persons already accredited and must always be used in conjunction with the primary accreditation card. They are only transferable within the MF's official delegation and appropriate function.

MF's are reminded that that ECh Seniors and Juniors are considered as only one event - this means that only one accreditation is prepared for the ECh. Example - Zone 1 - Coaches MAG Sen+Jun 2 = 2 for both age categories and not 2 for seniors and 2 for juniors.
