The selected CJP, CJP reserve, D and D reserve judges will be drawn / selected for the World Championships and the World Age Group Competition except for the D Judges at the WAGC. The R and R reserve judges will be appointed only for the World Championships.

Draw/Nominations Procedure:

The draw /selection begins by the Chair of Judges Panel (2), the reserve for CJP (draw by National Federation) followed by the Difficulty Judges (draw by National Federation) (4) and the reserves for D followed by the nomination of the R judges (8) and the reserves for R

Chair Judges

- 1. 2 CJP from all Cat. 1 judges.
- 1.1. Draw from all Cat. 1 judges, draw made by National Federation (art 4 AER Specific Judges Rules).
- 1.2. The order of the draw is:
 - a) Jury A CJP
 - b) Jury B CJP

Difficulty Judges

- 1. 4 D Judges (4 difficulty and 4 reserves) priority given to Cat 1.
 - draw by National Federation.
- 1.1. All D judges must come from a different NF, including the reserves.
- 1.2. The order of the draw is:
 - a) Jury A D 1
 - b) Jury B D 1
 - c) Jury A D 2
 - d) Jury B D 2

RESERVE FOR CJP and DIF

- e) Reserve 1
- f) Reserve 2

Reference Judges

- 1 Nomination of the Reference Judges from Category 1 and 2 judges.
- 1.1 General Criteria
 - Max 1 judge per federation
 - No R judge from a NF in the same panel as a CJP judge
 - No R Judge from a NF in the same panel as a D judge
 - All judges, based upon the results in the A and E examination made at the various courses of the current cycle
 - All judges based upon the minimum experience as follow:
 - Must have been 2 (two) times A / RA or E / RE judge respectively at either The World Games, World Championships, Continental Championships or World Cup in the past and/or current cycle).
 - Nomination made by name.
- 1.2 Criteria listed in order of priority
 - Must fulfill the general criteria mentioned above

- 1.3 The order of the nomination is the following:
 - a) RE1 Panel A
 - b) RE1 Panel B
 - c) RA1 Panel B
 - d) RA1 Panel A
 - e) RE2 Panel A
 - f) RE2 Panel B
 - g) RA2 Panel B
 - h) RA2 Panel A
 - i) Reserve RE Judge
 - j) Reserve RA Judge

Note to be included in the Directives for the WCH:

- If a NF rejects the draw/nomination as CJP, D Judge or R Judge, this judge may not be selected to another position for the same competition
- The draw for the E and A judges will be made at the judges' instruction at the World Championships. No E or A judge from the same NF may be drawn in a panel where his / her NF is already represented with a CJP, D or R judge. He / she will move directly to the other panel.
