

#### 6. INSURANCE

- The Host Federation, the Organizing Committee and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and the like. The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.
- The LOC will verify the insurance upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy).
- Delegation members with insufficient coverage must inform the LOC in advance. The LOC will subsequently offer insurance at the Federations' own charge as follows: CHF 170.- per person.

#### 7. WELCOME - OFFICIAL LANGUAGE

- The delegations will be welcomed on behalf of the Organizing Committee upon arrival in Arosa at the accreditation desk at the Sports and Conference Center, Poststrasse, 7050 Arosa.
- The official language of this world cup is English. Interpretation from and into any other language must be organized by the delegations. Announcements will be made in German and English only. The Work Plan and all other documents are available in English only.

#### 8. TRANSPORTATION

- All delegations must arrange their own transportation to Zurich Airport Arosa.
- The organizing committee will take care of the transportation of the delegations from Zurich Airport to Arosa, provided that transportation was ordered and paid in due time and notification of flight or train details have been given.
- Car rental is available at Zurich Airport.

#### 9. ACCREDITATION

- The accreditation system identifies individuals participating in the event and indicates that these individuals are permitted access. Heads of Delegation are required to verify the names of their entire delegation and the accommodation requirements. They have to pay any outstanding amounts due to the OC and / or the FIG and hand in national anthem and national flag at the moment of accreditation.

#### 10. HOTELS

- 13<sup>th</sup> April 2016 was the last date for definitive booking to the OC and deadline for payment of 50% of the accommodation packages to the OC. The remaining 50% have to be paid at latest at 18<sup>th</sup> May 2016.
- Most of the hotels are within walking distance of the competition venue. For all delegations which have booked the accommodation through the LOC, public transport is free of charge. The buses run on a regular schedule which will be handed out at the accreditation. A list of the hotels will be handed out to the head of delegation at the moment of accreditation.

- Please note that the latest check-out time is 11.00h at the day of departure.

#### 11. CANCELLATION

- The accommodation is only refundable, provided cancellations are made at least prior to 1st June 2016.

#### 12. MISCELLANEAOUS

- Please note that the Organizing Committee is <u>not</u> liable for any damages in the hotel rooms, costs for minibars, pay-TV or the like. This is the responsibility of each delegation.

#### 13. MEALS - INFORMATION

- Breakfast and dinner will be served in the respective hotels; lunch (if ordered) will be served at the competition Venue when vouchers are handed in. Unused vouchers will not be refunded.
- Lunch will be served 11.00h-14.00h at the competition venue in the Congress + Conference Room.

#### 15. ORIENTATION MEETING

- The Orientation Meeting will take place on Thursday June 23<sup>rd</sup> 2016 at 18.00h in the Meeting Room at the competition venue
- The orientation meeting is **compulsory for all Heads of Delegation**.

- At this meeting all information concerning the detailed organization of the World Cup will be given by the Organizing Committee and the FIG. **The meeting will be held in English only.** 

#### 16. DRAWING OF LOTS

- The draw for the starting order for the Qualification Round was done beforehand at the FIG headquarters.
- The final starting order will be established, printed and distributed to the delegations directly following the Orientation Meeting.

#### 17. EQUIPMENT

- Six trampolines as per FIG Norms will be used during competition.

#### 18. MUSIC

- The organizing committee would like to point out that **during the competition**, background music will be played at a low volume. Please let your gymnasts know this in advance. This has been approved by the FIG TD.

#### 19. JUDGES INSTRUCTION AND MEETING

The judges' instruction, which is **compulsory for all judges**, will take place on Thursday June 23<sup>rd</sup> 2016 at 18.30h in the Meeting Room at the competition venue. Please note that the judges' instruction will be held in English only. Judges who don't participate in the judges' instruction may not be authorized to judge and their respective federations may face a penalty fee of up to 2.000 CHF.

#### 20. DRAWING OF LOTS FOR JUDGES

- The judges will be drawn after the judges' instruction on Thursday June 23<sup>rd</sup> 2016 from those that were put forward by the federations. Judges must be duly licensed (valid FIG license with the appropriate requested category).

#### 21. COMPETITION CARDS

- Competition cards and athlete's profiles must be returned to the competition secretariat at the Orientation Meeting at the latest.

#### 22. PUBLICATION OF THE SCORES

- A detailed list of results, including judges' marks, will be distributed to the Heads of Delegation after the finals. During the competition, all results will be published in the venue, placed in each delegation's information box and will also be published on the official web-site.

#### 23. CHANGING ROOMS

- There are changing rooms for athletes and coaches, situated in the main venue. They are equipped with showers, toilets and hangers. Do not leave any valuables in the changing rooms.

#### 24. NO SMOKING POLICY

- Please note that it is strictly forbidden to smoke in the venue complex (including toilets and changing rooms).
- The government of the canton Graubünden put the partial revision of the health law on 1st March 2008 into effect. This means that in all publicly accessible, closed areas prohibition of smoking exists. Offences against the prohibition of smoking become in accordance with art. 49 paragraph 3 of the health law with

penalty up to CHF 100.00, in the instance of repetition up to CHF 500.00 punished. We ask you for information and thank for the adherence to the prohibition of smoking.

#### 25. MEDICAL SERVICES & ROOM

- The Organizing Committee will provide medical services. A special room with a massage table is marked with 'Medical + Massage Room'.

#### 26. DOPING CONTROL

Doping controls may be made during the World Cup - as per the FIG, IOC and WADA regulations - by the
organizing committee under supervision of the FIG. The doping controls can take place during training and /
or competition.

#### 27. MARCH IN

- The competitors are asked to assemble in the assembly area 5 minutes prior to each competition. The athletes have to wear the competition dress.
- The Judges are asked to be on their panel places and welcome the competitors during each march in.

#### 28. WARM UP

- Immediately prior to the **Qualifying Round** the competitors will have **10 minutes warm-up** on the competition apparatus.
- Immediately prior to the **Finals** each competitor/pair will be allowed **30 seconds** of warm-up on the competition apparatus.

#### 29. COMPETITION ATTIRE

- The competition dress is as per Code of Points

#### 30. VIDEO RECORDING

- All routines and passes will be recorded on videotapes.

#### 31. OPENING CEREMONY

- The short opening will take place Friday June 24<sup>th</sup> 2016 at 13.00h.

#### 32. AWARD CEREMONIES AND PRIZE MONEY

#### **31.1 AWARD CEREMONIES**

- The award ceremonies will take place immediately after the last final in the following order:
  - Trampoline Women / Men
  - Synchronised Women / Men
- Only the medal winners are invited to participate. They must appear in their **competition attire**.

#### **31.2 PRIZE MONEY**

- Prize money will be given as below.

- The prize money will be paid in CHF and given to the Head of Delegations at the banquet.

#### 33. WELCOME RECEPTION

- A Welcome Reception for the head of delegation and the judges will take place on Thursday June 23<sup>rd</sup> 2016 in the Foyer/VIP Lounge at the competition venue
- Admission by invitation only. All head of delegations, FIG members and judges are invited to the reception.

#### 34. BANQUET

- The banquet will take place on Saturday June 25<sup>th</sup> 2016 at 19.30h at the competition venue in the Congress + Conference Room. Admission by invitation only. All delegations which booked the accommodation through the LOC or have booked and paid the banquet separately are invited.

#### 35. MORE INFORMATION

- If you require more information about public transport, taxi or other things, please do not hesitate to contact our information desk.

#### **36. INFORMATION AND CORRESPONDANCE**

- Every delegation will have a mail box located at the competition office in the competition hall.
- All information requests and correspondence should be addressed to the Organizing Committee.

#### 37. TV & MEDIA and PRESS CONFERENCE




