<b>FEDERATIONS INVITED</b>	The Organizing Member Federation will invite all AGU Member Federations in good standing. Federations which have not fulfilled their annual membership fees towards the AGU, the FIG and not fulfilled their financial obligations towards the Organising Committee will not be allowed to participate in the Asian Championships.

<b>AGE LIMITS</b>	<p>* Age limit for Junior MAG: 14-17 years old (born between 1 January 2001 and 31 December 2004)  <b>In order to qualify for the YOG 2018 MAG gymnasts must be born between 1 January 2001 and 31 December 2002.</b>  * Age limit for Junior WAG: 13-15 years old (born between 1 January 2003 and 31 December 2005)  <b>In order to qualify for the YOG 2018 WAG gymnasts must be born between 1 January 2003 and 31 December 2003.</b></p>		
<b>FIG LICENSE</b>	<p><b>All gymnasts must present a valid FIG License until the end of the event, in order to be eligible to participate in an international competition.</b></p>		
<b>ENTRY FEES</b>	<p>No Entry Fee will be applied for this event.</p>		
<b>ACCREDITATION</b>	<p>Accreditations will be issue for the participants <b>only</b> if hotel reservations are made through the LOC.</p> <p>The accreditation will take place upon arrival of the delegations.</p> <p>Together with the nominative registration, the delegations must send to the LOC a passport photo of each delegation member(in electronic format). 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<b>COMPETITION FORMAT</b>	<p>The competitions will be conducted according to FIG's <i>Technical Regulations 2018</i> including Section 2 for Artistic Gymnastics, Reg. 5.1, where relevant, with the following modifications for both Junior and Senior.</p> <p>The competition consists of Men's and Women's Team Final, All-Around Final and Apparatus Qualifications and Finals.</p> <p><u>Team Final, All-Around Final, Apparatus Qualification</u>  <b>Competition Day1: MAG, Competition Day2: WAG</b></p> <p>Team and All-Around Final will also serve as the qualifications for the Apparatus Finals.</p> <p>A Team shall have not more than 4 gymnasts to compete on each apparatus and 3 highest scores will be taken into account for the Team total.</p> <p>For men, the competition consists of optional exercises on six apparatus.</p> <p>For women, the competition consists of optional exercises on four apparatus.</p> <p>To qualify for the vault finals, two vaults are necessary. The qualifying score is based on the average of the two scores.</p> <p>Only the first vault will count for the Team and All-Around ranking.</p> <p>The total scores of the gymnasts, who perform on all the apparatus in competition I, will determine the All-Around rankings (with maximum 2 gymnasts per federation).</p>		

	<p>The best ranked athletes (1 place/NOC) will grant a quota place to their NOC according to quotas stated in the FIG YOG Rules 2018.</p> <p>No tie-breaking rules will be applied for the Team and All-Around Finals. In case of a tie at any place, the tie is not broken.</p> <p>In the qualifications for the Apparatus Final, in case of ties, the tie-breaking rules as defined in the FIG TR according to art: 4.4.1.1. to 4.4.1.3.</p> <p><b>Apparatus Finals</b></p> <p>The results of the finals determine the champion on each apparatus. The top eight gymnasts on each apparatus from the Apparatus Qualifications shall be qualified to participate in the Apparatus Finals (with maximum 2 gymnasts per Federation).</p> <p>No tie-breaking rules will be applied for the Apparatus Finals. In case of a tie at any place, the tie is not broken.</p> <p><b>*Award Ceremonies</b></p> <p>Award ceremonies will be held after each competition. These gymnasts are required to attend the Awards ceremonies.</p> <p>The medals will be granted to the top 3 gymnasts/teams from each competition according to the result rankings.</p> <p>Tied gymnasts /teams will receive the same colored medal.</p>
