

AGE	Junior WAG: 13-15 years old by 31 December 2018. Junior MAG: 14-17 years old by 31 December 2018.
	All gymnasts must possess the FIG license valid from the moment of the nominative registration until the end of the event.
INFORMATION ABOUT THE QUALIFICATION FOR YOUTH	Only the gymnasts born in 2003 (WAG) and 2001-2002 (MAG) will be eligible to obtain a quota place for their NOC, based on the all-around results from the qualification competition.
OLYMPIC GAMES	See the enclosed documents: "FIG YOG Rules 2018" and "Buenos Aires YOG 2018 Qualification System".
JUDGES AND JURIES	Each Federation may register a maximum of 2 judges.
JUNES	Federations with PAGU TC Members can register that Member in addition to their registered judges.
	Federations can register a 3rd judge (different from the TC Member) as additional accredited person, with no cost for this accreditation.

	The fine for not registering the required number of judges in each discipline is USD\$1,000.00 per missing judge.

	The request must include the function, full name, gender, date of birth, citizenship and passport number, passport expiry date, the arrival and departure dates of the Delegation's member, as well as the city the visa application support letter must be sent to.
INSURANCE	The Host Federation, the LOC, the PAGU and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and the like.
	The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.
	The LOC will verify the insurance upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy). Delegation members with insufficient insurance cover must inform the LOC in advance no later than <u>14 May 2018</u> .
