COMPETITION FORMAT	<p>ART:</p> <p>There are Qualifications & All-Around Final, Team Final and Apparatus Finals. The competitions will be conducted according to MAG, WAG code of points and FIG's <i>Technical Regulations 2018</i></p>																								

1- Qualifying Team, Individual and All-Around Final

The results obtained determine:

- The qualification for the Team Final and for the Apparatus Finals.
- This competition determines the All-Around Individual Champions.

This competition is organized by a rotation of groups. Each group comprises a team of 3-5 gymnasts. A team shall assign not more than four (4) gymnasts to compete on each apparatus and the best three (3) scores on each apparatus will be taken into account for team total or 1~2 gymnasts to compete in individual competitions.

2- Team Final

The results of Team Final determine the winner of the Team Championships.

The 8 teams having obtained the highest total scores in Qualifications take part in this competition consisting of six exercises for men and four exercises for women.

A team consists of 3 to 5 gymnasts. Three (3) gymnasts compete on each apparatus. All scores will be added together for the total.

The results of Qualifications are not carried forward to Team Final (start from zero).

No tie-breaking rules will be applied.

3- Apparatus Finals

The top 8 gymnasts (maximum two per NOC) qualified from each of the apparatus for men and women in the Qualifications will perform on Apparatus Finals. Each NOC shall enter not more than two gymnasts to compete in the Apparatus Finals. The starting order shall be decided by drawing lots.

RG:

1- Qualifying individual Competition with Team ranking

A team may consist of three or four gymnasts. Each gymnast may subject to compliance with the following requirement and perform one to four exercises (maximum).

The competition programme is composed of exercises using the four (4) apparatus on prescribed in the programme of the year 2018. Each team must perform three exercises with each apparatus by different gymnasts, making a total of 12 exercises.

The team classification is made by adding up the 10 best scores registered by the gymnasts of the team.

Individual All-Around

24 best gymnasts qualify to the All –Around by the results of the 3 best exercises in Qualification. Gymnasts are divided into two groups based on the results of Qualification (maximum two gymnasts per NOC).

The programme consists of four (4) exercises with the four (4) prescribed apparatus and the classification is made by adding the four scores obtained with the four apparatus.

The results of Qualification will not be taken into account.

TRA:

Trampoline competition is divided in two phases, Qualification Round and the Final Round. The competitions comprise three routines with 10 elements in each routine.

The competitions will be conducted according to Trampoline code of points and FIG's Technical Regulations 2018

1- Qualifying Round

There are two routines in the Qualifying Round. The first routine includes

both free and special requirements, in which the execution score is added to the difficulty score of two free elements to give the total for a routine. The second routine is a voluntary routine, in which the execution score is added to the difficulty score to give the total for a routine. The eight men and eight women with the best total scores from these two routines qualify for the final (maximum two per NOC). Scores from the qualifying round do not carry over to the final.

2- Final Round

According to FIG 2017-2020 Code of Points,

- The total score for first routine = execution + difficulty (4 skills with difficulty) + time of flight + Horizontal Displacement
- The total score for second routine = execution + difficulty + time of flight + Horizontal Displacement
- The total score for final routine = execution + difficulty + time of flight + Horizontal Displacement
