INVITED FEDERATIONS	PAGU Member Federations, who are currently up to date with their obligations with PAGU and FIG, and who belong to the Central American and Caribbean Area.	
AGE LIMITS	Senior: 16 years old and older Junior: 13-15 years old Age will be determined by 31 December 2017. All gymnasts must have a valid FIG licence until the end of the event.	
JUDGES AND JURIES	All judges must have a valid FIG brevet at the time of the event for the respective discipline RGI and/or RGG. The Technical Delegate will preside the Superior Jury and PAGU will nominate the members of the Jury of Appeal. Delegations that do not register at least one judge must inform PAGU before the Nominative Registration deadline and pay a fine of US\$1,000.00. This fine will not apply to the national federations that have no judges with FIG brevet.

ACCREDITATIONS

Along with the Nominative Registration all federations must send a copy of the passport and a photograph (white background) of each delegation members (official and additional).

Photos:

Each photo should meet the following requirements:

- File format: JPEG
- Measures: 210 x 270 pixels minimum and 420 x 540 pixels maximum
- 35 mm width by 45 mm height
- File size: no more than 1 MB

Each document must be identified with the country and name of each member. Example: Country, LAST NAME-Name and function.

These documents must be sent no later than <u>3 June 2017</u>. In case of not sending the photo as described, the LOC will take it upon arrival with an extra cost of USD\$10.00 per photo.

The cost of the accreditation for additional persons (coaches, team leaders, doctors and physiatrists) will be USD\$100.00 each one. This accreditation will give them the right to enter the areas according to the function, local transportation and Farewell Banquet.

The cost of the additional accreditations must be paid to the LOC by bank transfer no later than 15 May 2017.

In case of theft or loss of the accreditation, it must be informed immediately to Local Organization Committee for the cancellation of the accreditation.

The replacement of the lost or stolen accreditation will cost USD\$50.00 to the holder of the accreditation.

EVENT FORMAT

Individuals Seniors and Juniors

- A maximum of 4 gymnasts per category may participate.
- For the team competition on each category, the gymnasts may present a maximum of 12 routines and the best 10 scores will count.
- 2 days of qualifying competition (2 apparatus per day). The results of this phase will determine the final ranking for Teams, All Around and the qualification for Appartus Finals, for juniors as well as for seniors.
- 1 day of apparatus finals
 - 4 apparatus Juniors
 - 4 apparatus Seniors

Groups

- 2 days of qualifying competition (1 routine per day). The results of this
 phase will determine the final All Around ranking and the qualification for
 Appartus Finals.
- 1 day of apparatus finals (2 routines)

The competition will follow the PAGU and FIG valid rules.

	The request must include the function, full name, gender, date of birth, nationality, passport number, passport expiry date, arrival and departure dates, as well as the city where the visa will be issued.
MEDICAL INSURANCE	The Host Federation, the Organizing Committee, the PAGU and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation, etc.
	The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and repatriation for all the members of their delegation.
	Please submit proof of insurance to the LOC by <u>3 June 2017.</u> Delegation Members with insufficient insurance coverage must inform the Local Organizing Committee in advance.
	The LOC will offer an insurance to all Delegations that require it. The cost is US\$75.00 per person and includes the official dates of the event.
INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORT	Participating Federations are responsible for the international transportation of their delegation members. They must arrive to the International Airport La Aurora in Guatemala City.
	The Travel Itinerary form must be sent to the Local Organizing Committee no later than 3 June 2017.
LOCAL TRANSPORTATION	The Local Organizing Committee will provide local transportation from airport to the hotel and vice versa in the official arrival and departure days.
