Accommodation Policy	The Accommodation Form must be returned to the LOC by January 15 <sup>th</sup> , 2019 at the very latest, the hotel rooms will be allocated on a "first come, first serve" basis. The invited participating federations must pay for the accommodation expenses of their delegation members. <b>The costs for the accommodation</b> <b>must be paid to the LOC as follows: 50% until January 15th, 2019 and</b> <b>the rest 50% until February 15<sup>th</sup>, 2019.</b> Please notify the LOC for your choice on the hotel class when your provisional registration is made. <b>Cancellation/Reimbursement Policy:</b> 50% of accommodation costs are refundable in case of cancellations at least 1 month prior to arrival. The request must include the function, full name, gender, date of birth, citizenship and passport number, passport expiry date, arrival and departure dates of the Delegation Members as well as the city the visa application support letter must be sent to.
Insurance	The Host Federation, the Organizing Committee and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and the like. The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation. The LOC will verify the insurance upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy). Delegation members with insufficient insurance cover must inform the LOC in advance.
