	The competition consists of Men's and Women's Team Final, All-Around Final and Apparatus Qualification and Final.		
	Team Final, All-Around Final, Apparatus Qualifications Competition Day1: MAG, Competition Day2: WAG		
	Team and All-Around Final will also serve as the qualifications for the Apparatus Final.		
	A Team shall have not more than 4 gymnasts to compete on each apparatus and 3 highest scores will be taken into account for the Team total.		
	For men, the competition consists of optional exercises on six apparatus.

	To qualify for the vault finals, two vaults are necessary. The qualifying score is based on the average of the two scores. Only the first vault will count for the Team and All-Around ranking. The top eight gymnasts on each apparatus from the Apparatus Qualifications shall be qualified to participate in the Apparatus Finals (with maximum 2 gymnasts per Federation). No tie-breaking rules will be applied for the Apparatus Finals. In case of a tie at any place, the tie is not broken. <u>*Award Ceremonies</u> Award ceremonies will be held after each competition. These gymnasts are required to attend the Awards ceremonies. The medals will be granted to the top 3 gymnasts/teams from each competition according to the result rankings.
