FEDERATIONS INVITED	<p>The Organizing Member Federation will invite all Member Federations whose gymnasts qualify according to Grand Prix Regulations 2019.</p>
GRAND PRIX SUPERVISOR	<p>The LOC, according to Grand Prix Regulations, will cover the flight tickets, accommodation, meals and 50 EUR per day including the days of travel for two official Supervisors from the Grand Prix Committee for the period of March 15-18, 2019 (3 nights).</p>
AGE LIMITS	<p>Senior gymnasts: born in 2003 or before.</p> <p>Only Gymnasts with the correct age and holding a valid FIG License, valid until the end of the event, may participate.</p>

According to FIG rules, the LOC will pay to FIG a fee equal to 5% of the Prize Money (1125 EUR) after the end of competitions. According to Grand Prix Regulations, the LOC will pay 1667 EUR as a part of the Winner's Prize of the Grand Prix Series 2019.
