GYMNASTS' HAND APPARATUS	The changes of the Apparatus Norms for the Hand Apparatus valid for Apparatus Manufacturers and Gymnasts enter into force from 01 January 2019. The list of the RG Hand Apparatus with valid certificates is published on the FIG website (<u>here</u>) and updated regularly. Make sure that your gymnasts use only FIG certified Hand Apparatus for this event and for any other FIG recognized competitions, as they will not be allowed to compete with an Apparatus which does not comply with the norms.		
	Random checks on the FIG and Manufacturers' Logos will be carried out at any time during the Event.

AGE LIMITS	Junior: 13-15 Senior: 16 and older All gymnasts must have a licence valid until the end of the event.		
JUDGES AND JURIES	All judges must have a current valid FIG brevet (min. IV) at the time of the event, in the respective disciplines.

MEDICAL SERVICES	The medical services will be provided by the Bulgarian Sports Medicine Centre. Doctor in charge: Dr. Maria Bobeva.			
VISA	Please verify immediately with your travel agent or the Bulgarian Embassy or Consulate in your country if a visa is required for your travel to Bulgaria. The Organizing Committee will be happy to assist each Delegation member with an official invitation letter, provided that the request is made by <u>15th</u> <u>February 2019</u> to the OC. The request must include the function, full name, gender, date of birth, citizenship and passport number, passport expiry date, the arrival and departure dates of the Delegation Member as well as <u>the city of the Bulgarian Consular Department</u> to which the official visa support letter must be sent. Note: Bulgaria applies a visa-free system for holders of <u>valid</u> Schengen			
INSURANCE	visas. The Host Federation, the LOC and the FIG will not be held responsible for			
	any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and the like. The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.			
	The LOC will verify the insurance upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy). Delegation members with insufficient insurance cover must inform the LOC in advance.			
	The LOC will subsequently offer insurance at the Federations own charge as follows: 20 euro per person.			
INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION	The invited participating federations must pay for the travel costs of their delegation members. The Travel Schedule Form must be returned to the LOC by 15 th March 2019.			
LOCAL TRANSPORTATION	The LOC will arrange the local transportation (i.e. from/to the airport, railway station and/or bus station as well as from/to the hotel and the Venue).
