Special regulation Kata Individual U10, U12 and U14:

Kata from both AKA and AO will be performed simultaneously on the tatami until the semi-finals.

- *U10:* two different Kata
- *U12:* three different Kata
- *U14:* four different Kata

Cadets, Juniors, U21: WKF rules 2019

Kata Team Cadets & U21 follow the same rules as WKF Kata Team Juniors Bunkai in medal fights obligatory for Kata Team categories U14 and older.

Modus Kumite:

Kumite U12, U14:	Groups will be arranged according to weight.

Cadets, Juniors, U21: WKF rules

Kumite Team categories will follow the WKF rules for Individual Kumite and senior Kumite Team categories but with only 3 competitors. Teams may consist of athletes from different dojos, but must all be from the same country. Each athlete can only be registered for one team. <u>No repechage</u> in the Kumite Open and Kumite Team categories!



















Compulsory Kumite Protective Equipment

Karate gloves, shin pad and foot protectors (red/blue), body protector, chest protector (female only), groin protector (male ony) and mouthguard.

Face masks will not be required during this tournament.

Condition for participation

All athletes with a valid membership card from their national federation. Coaches/Carers are responsible for medical certificates and parental consent.
