#### 2. Introduction

#### a) Introduction

- Nairobi Open is the most important Karate event in the Calendar of the Kenya Karate Federation Metropolitan Region 2019.
- It is designed to accommodate **Children** (# 13 years), **Cadets** & **Juniors** (14 17 years), **adults** (18 39 years), Veterans (40+ years), and endeavors to bring together the best Karate athletes within and outside the Kenya Karate Federation Metropolitan Region in an open Championships of unprecedented scale and quality.
- The event offers all Karate athletes, of similar weight categories and modalities, an opportunity to challenge for top honors and pride without any restrictions of grades/belts possessed, thus stating Karate's impact all around the ranks world over.
- The city of Nairobi hosts the 2019 Nairobi Open Individual Karate Championship for Children, Cadets, Juniors,
   Adults and Veterans

#### b) About Nairobi



- Kenya's capital city, Nairobi, is the most dynamic city, also known as the "green city in the sun". It is Kenya's largest city with a population of nearly four million
- It is also Kenva's principal economic, administrative and cultural centre.
- Nairobi hosts headquarter of diplomatic missions and multinational brands in Africa. Organizations with headquarters
  in Nairobi, Kenya include United Nations Environment Programme and the United Nations.
- The skyscrapers of Nairobi sit on what was once a large swamp that Maasai pastoralists referred to as 'nairobe'the place of cool waters, and thus the coined name.
- In addition to its urban core, Nairobi is one of the few cities in the world, and the only one in Africa, with a national
  park. Set alongside its southern suburbs, Nairobi National Park a large game reserve known for breeding endangered
  black rhinos and home to giraffes, zebras and lions is right next to the city. Next to, it is a well-regarded elephant
  orphanage operated by the David Sheldrick Wildlife Trust.
- Although Nairobi is situated a few degrees south of the equator, its high altitude between 1,660m and 1,800m above sea level –
  means that the city's climate is mild year-round. Visitors are spared the extreme, blistering temperatures found in other regions
  of Africa, or even other areas within Kenya.
- Nairobi's rapid growth has seen an increase in the number of modern shopping complexes. The top shopping malls include Thika Road Mall (TRM), Yaya Centre, The Junction and Garden City, all within reach of the city centre.

means competitors must have the eligible age by 16<sup>th</sup> of February 2019.

## c) Weight Categories

- Confirmation of the <u>individual weights</u> will be on the morning of Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> February 2019 as stated in the
   <u>Competition Programme</u> below. We advise every Kumite athlete to be at the Competition venue in time for the same,
   failure to which, we will decline participation in the concerned category.
- Exemption will be given for a (+/-) 1 Kg in any weight category. Anything less or more will warrant a Disqualification

#### 7. General Information

- The Nairobi Open 2019 Karate Championship for Children, Cadets, Juniors, Adults and Veterans will be conducted under the WKF Referee Rules New Version.
- 2. The competitions will last Two (2) Days, (16th and 17th February 2019).
- For Registration purposes, a clear copy of an identification document in the form of a National ID card or National Passport for (Adults and Veterans); Students ID Card; Birth Certificate, or Baptism Card for (Children, Cadets & Juniors); MUST accompany the Registration data to enable timely and efficient process.
- 4. For Kata event, contestants may perform any KATA provided it is in the WKF Kata list, version 2018.
  - No 'Novice' or 'Senior' Kata restrictions in this event

#### 8. Awards & Incentives

- All Three (3) Medalists in every category will receive a Winners Medal and a Certificate of Performance
- ALL the Registered Participants and their Clubs / Institutions will get a Certificate of Participation.
- The Organizing Committee of the Nairobi Open Karate Championship and the Leadership of the Region is at
  the forefront engaging a number of corporate bodies, Institutions and like-minded persons, on the need to come
  up with a convincing package (s) as an incentive to all the medalists, and to some extent, selected athletes.
- We will communicate the same to the public, as and when we reach an agreement (s) as concerns the same.

#### 9. Referees

- The Referees permitted to officiate in Nairobi Open Karate Championship 2019 MUST possess Referee and/or Judges Qualifications from KKF Metropolitan Region; Kenya Karate Federation; UFAK and/or WKF Referee course level.
- Every interested Referee and/or Judge MUST Fill and Sign the attached Referee Registration Form, and return
  it on or before 9th February 2019 for purposes of selection and listing.

#### 10. Coaches

- The minimum level required to take part in Nairobi Open Karate Championship is "Accredited Coach" level.
- To obtain such certification, coaches must Fill and Sign both the <u>Coaches' Registration Form</u> and
   "<u>Accreditation Agreement for Coaches"</u> attached, and attend a compulsory "<u>Accredited Coach Briefing</u>" on the I<sup>st</sup> day of the Championship (16<sup>th</sup> February 2019), as communicated in the Competition Program.
- The fee to attend the "Accredited Coach Briefing" and secure rights to sit at the Coaches' seat and mediate
  for your competitor (s) in the Nairobi Open is Kshs 300, payable to the Treasurer of KKF Metropolitan Region.

## 11. Individual Membership Card (Metro' ID)

- Karate-kas in possession of the Metro' ID Card, will enjoy a 20% discount on Entry Charges levied in any category or modality during the Nairobi Open Karate Championship 2019.
- The 20% discount will also apply to any merchandise sold by appointed member (s) of the Region, and/or any other partnered company or person during the said Championship, as will be communicated beforehand.
- Important to note is that the discount is <u>NOT</u> transferable to any other person and the same would apply only
  upon producing the Metro' Membership Card.

## 12. Anti-Doping

- In compliance with the WKF Anti-doping rules and WADA, any Karate athlete may be subjected to a <u>random</u> and unannounced Doping test at any given time. We thereby advice Athletes to stay clean, win clean.
- In case of Therapeutic Use Exemptions (TUE), kindly contact the National Anti-Doping Organization for further
  details and recognition. This will then be dully communicated (in writing) to the KKF Metropolitan Region Office

#### 13. Insurance

- In compliance with the WKF rules, it is obligatory for all the participants and members of the participating delegation have their own medical and personal trip insurance.
- The Kenya Karate Federation Metropolitan Region as well as the <u>organizing committee</u> assumes no liability or responsibility for the lack of insurance from participants and members of the delegation.
- The heads of delegations have to sign the enclosed terms of responsibility and return it on or before the first day of Championship (February 16, 2019)
