JUDGES AND JURIES	 The participating member federations must send minimum 1 qualified judge if they participate with individual gymnasts. For the FIG-competition Senior and Junior – All judges must have a current valid FIG-Brevet at the time of the event for the respective discipline (RGI). Priority will be given to the highest categories. The Organizing Member Federation will apply a fine of 100 EUR per missing judge (to be paid to the LOC by 31 October 2019) should a federation fail to bring the required number of judges or judges without the requested qualification (brevet).
