7th European Championships in Freestyle and Greco-Roman wrestling Championship among deaf athletes (7th European Deaf Wrestling Championships);

3rd European Championship in Freestyle and Greco-Roman wrestling among deaf cadets and juniors (3rd European Deaf Cadet and Junior Wrestling Championships) (European Championship) is held in accordance with the international calendar 2019 which is approved by the European Deaf Sport Organization (EDSO).

Confirmation of the final registered application by type of program should be submitted to the wrestling technical Director of EDSO no later than September 28, 2019 (1 month prior to the beginning of competitions).

Changes or additions to the application form will be allowed after September 28, 2019 only after the payment of a fine of 50 Euros.

Athletes who cannot participate because of medical reasons are exempt from the fine. In this case a doctor's conclusion is required.

National Federations are responsible for the timely submission of the applications.

Each member of the team must have a medical insurance policy which is valid in the territory of the Republic of Belarus.

DATE AND VENUE

The European Championship will be held from October 28 to November 3, 2019 in Gomel (Republic of Belarus) in the athletics arena of the state institution "Gomel regional center of Olympic reserve in athletics" (hereinafter - GOTSOR) at the address: Gomel, Yubileinaya str, 52.

PARTICIPANTS

Athletes who have a valid ID number of the International Committee of Sports for the Deaf (ICSD) are allowed to participate in competitions:

Senior – minimum 18 years of age (born in 2001). Medical insurance is important.

Junior – aged 18 to 20 years (born in 1999 – 2001). It is important to have medical certificate and parents' permission Athletes aged 17 years) to participate in competitions.

Cadet – aged 15 to 17 years (2002 – 2004 year of birth). It is important to have medical certificate and parents' permission to participate in competitions. Athletes at the age of 14 years within the years of birth are permitted to participate.

Maximum 1 competitor per weight category for every federation.

Each team has the right to present the judge who is a part of the delegation. All judges expenses to be provided by the national federation.

ACCREDITATION

Greco-Roman wrestling - 28 – 29 October 2019,

Freestyle - 30 – 31 October 2019

Press conference for media representatives will be held in October 28, 2019 at 17.30.

About all travelling details please inform the organizing Committee 2 months prior to the start of competition (no later than 28th of August 2019).

Greco-Roman technical meeting will be held on October 28, 2019 at 3 p.m.

Freestyle technical meeting will be held on October 31, 2019 at 5 p.m.

Training will be held in accordance with the schedule.

DRAW

The draw for participation in the competition is held in accordance with the rules of UWW.

Before going on the mat, the athlete must present an accreditation card. On a mat the athlete is obliged to leave only accompanied by the second.

MEDICAL CONTROL

Every athlete must have an accreditation card during the medical control.

Each athlete is provided 30 minutes to make his weight. In case of excess of the declared weight, the athlete is not allowed to compete.

CONTROL DURING AND AFTER COMPETITIONS

Doping control: Any athlete can be called for doping control in accordance with WADA rules.

Audiometric control: Any athlete can be called to pass audiometric tests of hearing in accordance with EDSO.

It is forbidden to use hearing AIDS or external cochlear implants during the competition (This is strictly prohibited).

FINANCIAL CONDITIONS

National Federations cover expenses for:

Transportation from /to Minsk airport (Minsk railway) – Gomel on arrival and departure day is 20 Euro per person.

Accommodation:

double-triple room – 60 Euro per person (including Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner)

single room – 80 Euro per person (including Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner)

IMPORTANT!!! National federations can make payments for transportation and accommodation only by bank transfer or credit card on arrival. NO CASH IS ALLOWED!

PARTICIPATION FEE:

EDSO fee:

According to ICSD Regulation the participation fee for each athlete is of 20 Euro and for each official 30 Euro is required. Must be paid directly to the EDSO Office before the competition will start.

OC fee:

To support the competitions a contribution fee for each person of 40 Euro was arranged and is to be paid to the OC by Cash before the competitions will start.

In case of discrepancy of the declared sportsmen there will be a fee of EUR 50, to be paid to the EDSO representative, in accordance with the EDSO regulations, with the exception of those who present a certified opinion of a physician that an athlete cannot participate for health reasons.

VISA:

If there is a visa communication between your country and the Republic of Belarus, we inform you that VISAS will be issued to all participants of the European Championship free of charge.

If you arrive by plane at the national airport "Minsk", visa up to 30 days will be issued free of charge at the Minsk airport, according to the Decree of the President of the Republic of Belarus. We will help you to travel to Gomel and back. At the same time, the departure from Belarus is also only from the airport "Minsk".

If you arrive at the airport "Minsk" through Russia, in this case, the visa must be issued in advance in your country.

If you arrive by means of land transport (train, bus), you should promptly apply with our invitation from Belarus to the Embassy of the Republic of Belarus in Your country, where the visa will be issued free of charge.

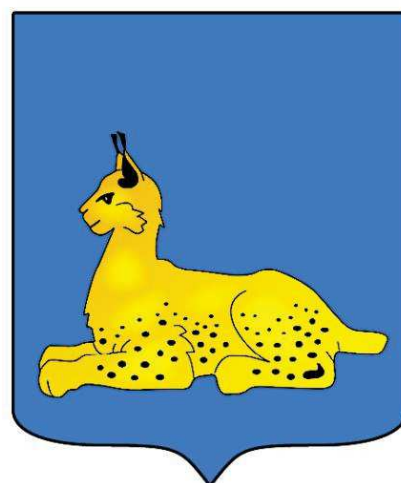

It is open to all forms of cooperation and always faithful to the traditions of hospitality.

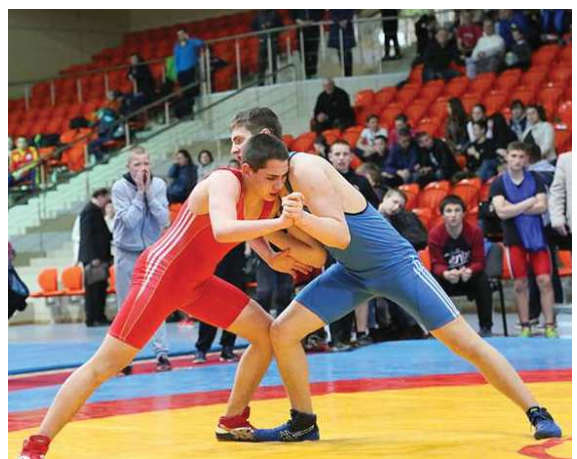

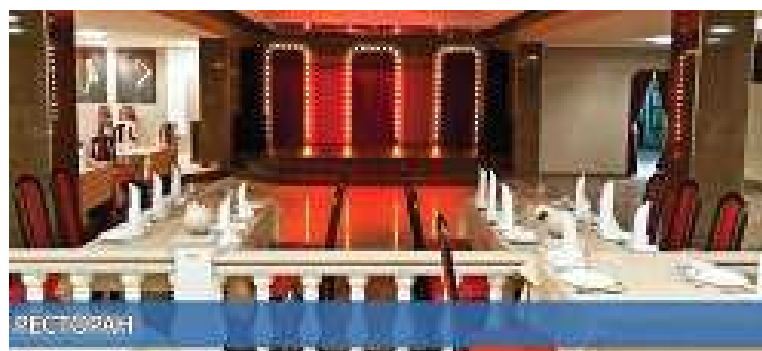
