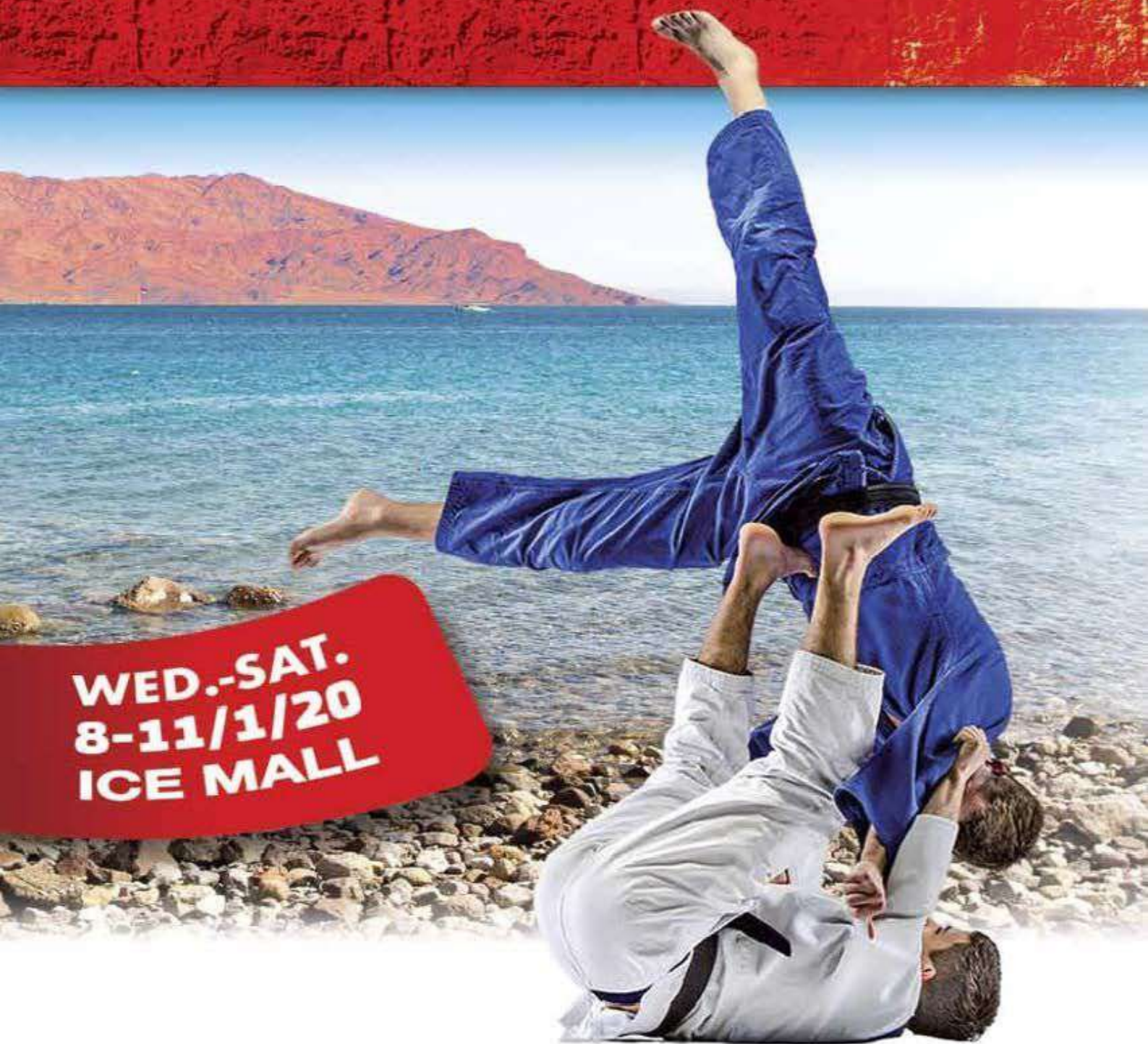


ELAT JUDO FESTIVAL ISRAEL 2020

A yearly flagship event organized by the Israel Judo Association that includes the association cup for various ages, with participation of over a 1000 Judoka and training sessions. 5. Participation

This international red sea Judo Cup is open for all. There is no limit in the number of participation for each weight category for every federation.

6. Categories

Age group: 2008-2011

Boys: 24, 27, 30, 34, 38, 42, 46, 50, +50.

Girls: 20, 24, 28, 32, 36, 40, 44, +44.

Age group: 2006-2007

Boys: 34, 38, 42, 46, 50, 55, 60, +60.

Girls: 32, 36, 40, 44, 48, 52, 57, +57.

Age group: 2005 and above

Man: 43, 46, 50, 55, 60, 66, 73, 81, 90, 100, +100.

Women: 40, 44, 48, 52, 57, 63, 70, 78, +78.

7. Accreditation & Control of Nationality

At least one team official and maximum two must attend the accreditation on Wednesday from 12:00 to 15:00 in order to confirm the delegation.

8. Competition Mode

The competition will be conducted in accordance with the latest IJF SOR and IJF Refereeing Rules. In addition, unique laws of the Israeli referee committee- please see below.

Competition systems according to number of participants:

- 6 and more entries: Double repechage
- 3,4,5 entries: Round robin

Less than 3 entries per category: the competitor will be allowed to move to the next weight category. If the weight category is the highest one, then the competitor will be allowed to move to the next age category.

9. Weigh-in

The official weigh in of athletes will be scheduled the day before the competition at 16:30 (see program).

Athletes are not allowed to weigh-in naked. Boys must wear at least underwear and girls at least underwear and a T-shirt. Additional 400g will be allowed for their weight category limits.



Athletes must present accreditation card and his/her passport (National ID Card showing nationality and date of birth are also accepted).

All bank fees and money transfer costs must be paid by the sender federation or club.

Israeli's referee committee additional rules:

1. Contest area: in official tournaments for children, the size of the contest area will not be smaller than 5x5 m. and for cadets not smaller than 6x6 m.
2. Children age group 2008-2011 : Direct attack to the knees or hips (as drop down seionage or tama gruma) will not be awarding score, will not be used for transfer to ne waza, second attempt for this technic (and more) will be punished with Shido. Oke can choose to transfer to ne waza.
3. Children age group 2008-2011: Counter attacks involving breaking the technic to the back will not be awarding score, will not be used for transfer to ne waza. Oke can choose to transfer to ne waza.
4. Children age group 2008-2011: It is not allowed to conduct the fight while hugging the head. It is allowed to hold the judogi in the back of the neck and on the scapula on the same side (but not on the opposite side), it is possible to attack while hugging the head (like koshi goruma and kobi nage) but the attack must be immediate. crushing down is not allowed.
5. Children age group 2006-2007 : shime waza is allowed, kansetso waza is not allowed.
