	<p>Medical Diagnostics From through World Taekwondo Classification System (WTCS) Following IPC Guidelines on data protection concerning athletes and personal classification information. World Taekwondo has in connection with IPC created the World Taekwondo Classification System (WTCS). World Taekwondo Classification System (WTCS) is our new online registration tool for MNAs to register their new athletes and add Medical Diagnostic Forms (MDF) and pictures to be seen by our Classification Evaluation Committee in order to determine if the new athlete is eligible for Para Taekwondo and meets Minimum Impairment Criteria (MIC). WORLD RANKING AND SEEDING	<p>The Kyorugi (K44/K43 Sport Classes) competitions of the 2020 at the Oceania Qualification Tournament for TOKYO 2020 Paralympic Games. Athletes will be seeded in accordance with the WT World Para Taekwondo Competition Rules.</p>
METHOD OF COMPETITION	<p>Kyorugi The competitions in the K40 Sport Classes at the Oceania Qualification Tournament for TOKYO 2020 Paralympic Games will be held in single elimination tournament system The duration of contest shall be three (3) rounds of two (2) minutes each with a one (1) minute rest period between rounds. In the case of a tied score after the completion of the third (3rd) round, a fourth (4th) round of two (2) minutes will be conducted as the Golden Point round, after a one (1) minute rest period following the third (3rd) round. The duration of contest may be adjusted to one (1) minute x 3 rounds, one (1) minute 30 seconds x three (3) rounds with a 30 second to one (1) minute break between rounds upon the decision of the Technical Delegate for the pertinent Championships.</p>
RESEARCH	<p>WT will conduct research in para taekwondo kyorugi competition performance factors. Injury surveillance research as well as research into athlete classification will also be conducted during the Oceania Qualification Tournament for TOKYO 2020 Paralympic Games. <p>HEAD OF TEAM MEETING & DRAWING OF LOTS</p>	<p>The Head of Team meeting shall be conducted by WTO officials on 28 February 2019. Exact location and time shall be communicated forthwith.</p>
<p>WEIGH-IN</p>	<p>Weigh-in of the athletes takes place the day prior to the start of the respective weight category they compete in. During the weigh-in, the male athlete shall wear underpants and the female athlete shall wear underpants and brassiere. However, the athlete may weigh in nude if he/she wishes to do so.</p> <p>Each athlete shall have one (1) attempt to pass the weigh in. However, one (1) extra attempt is allowed for those athletes who did not qualify the first time. This extra attempt shall be done within the time limit of the official weigh-in.</p>
<p>COUNTRY ENTRY VISA</p>	<p>A Visa to enter Australia may be necessary.</p> <p>The visa recommendation letters will be automatically generated from WT GMS platform if the visa requested during the registration for the event. All the members who need entry visa to Australia must be registered in GMS.
