Individual program:

Diplomas and presents for all gymnasts.

Each category (declared in the Propositions) from 1st to 3rd place gets medals. A and B program: Awarding in all around and 1st to 3rd place by each apparatus. Winner of the Competition is awarded with the Tournament Cup.

#### Group program:

Diplomas and presents for all gymnasts.

Each category (declared in propositions) from 1st to 3th place gets medals

#### Entrance fee:

Individual exercises - seniors and juniors A program - 45 € per gymnast.

Individual exercises - other categories - 35 € per gymnast.

Group exercises - 15 € per gymnast.

Fee for missing judge - 50 € euro per team

Gymnast who compete in individual program may participate in group exercises if pay both entrance fees.

Hotel Novi Sad is the main hotel of the tournament, where the technical meeting, banquet and the disco night after the competition will take place. It is located near Main bus and Railway station. Hotel parking with 60 parking places is provided free of charge. Parking for Buses is provided at a Bus station, across the hotel. Competition hall is 2 km away, just along the boulevard.
