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AGE LIMITS	<p>Seniors competition: 15 and more, Gymnasts born 2001 and older; Juniors competition: 13-19 - born 2003 - 1997; AGE group: 12-18 - born 2004 – 1998; 11-16 - born 2005 – 2000.</p> <p>In the junior's and AGE group competitions, the difficulty mark is limited according to the World AGE group competitions rules and to FIG Code of Points. All gymnasts must have a valid FIG license.</p>

ENTRY FEES	The invited participating Federations must pay for all entry fees. The cost for the entry fees is 30 euro per gymnast.				
ACCREDITATION	<p>Accreditations are distributed at the Sport Komplex at the arrival of the Delegations.</p> <p>Photo of the delegation member is not compulsory.</p> <p>The accreditation system identifies individuals participating in the Seniors and Age Group Competition (i.e.: competitors and teams from FIG affiliated federations, in good standing and with the correct age) and ensures controlled access to each area. All participants and officials are required to wear Accreditation Cards at all times.</p> <p>At accreditation, the Heads of Delegation must check the correct names of their complete Delegation; verify accommodation and meal requirements, make the necessary payments (insurance, etc.), hand in their national anthem, their national flag, and the competitors' music CD. They also have to present the passports of all competitors and judges for the control of Nationality and age. The definitive work plan will be given to the Head of Delegation by accreditation.</p>				
PLANNED COMPETITION FORMAT	<p>The Zolotov Cup Seniors and Juniors, AGE groups consist of Qualifications and Finals in all 5 categories.</p> <p><u>Qualifications:</u> 1 Balance + 1 Dynamic Exercise</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Competitors cannot participate in a final without competing in both the dynamic and balance qualifying events. - The places after qualifications are determined by the sum of scores from the two exercises, Balance and Dynamic - The top 8 proceed to the final with no more than one per federation in each discipline. If there are less than 12 entries to a category, only 6 may proceed to the final. <p><u>Finals:</u> 1 Combined Exercise</p> <p>Overall winners in each discipline will be defined by the highest total scores for performance of three exercises (preliminary balance, preliminary dynamic and final combined exercise). Only one delegation from country will be rewarded.</p>

To make a request is necessary to send to the LOC the copy of the National passport (page with name, number of passport, expiry date). It must be also written the name of the city, wear delegation will receive visa. Travel Form arrival and departure dates of the Delegation Member.</p>	
INSURANCE	<p>The Host Federation, the LOC and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and the like.</p> <p>The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.</p> <p>The LOC will verify the insurance upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy).</p> <p>Delegation members with insufficient coverage must inform the LOC in advance.</p> <p>The LOC will subsequently offer insurance at the Federations own's charge as follows: 10 Euro per person/day.</p>
