We are happy to invite you to our <u>First Rhythmic Gymnastics Body Difficulty Online</u>
<u>Test on 19–20 December 2020</u>. Gymnasts are welcome to test their Body Difficulty skills and to compete with each other internationally!

We have prepared Christmas surprises for the winners in each category!

GENERAL OBJECTIVES:

Body Difficulties (BD) play an important role in the Rhythmic Gymnastics score. The BD test will help coaches and gymnasts:

- To evaluate and confirm best BD for the gymnasts to use in their routines
- To educate the gymnasts about the importance of a clean BD execution
- To understand the BD technical faults and how they affect the score
- To motivate the gymnasts to work towards higher level of difficulty (test offers rankings)

Age groups: 2014 YOB and older. This particular test is for Body Difficulty without apparatus.

Definition :BD elements are the elements from the Difficulty Tables in the current Code of Points , FIG

! This test can be organised within a school/club/ federation, as a routine test, or as a competition; nationally or internationally, alone or as a part of a full evaluation*. Should you wish to organise the test for your organisation only, please contact us for the assistance with an integrated registration, scoring and results for your club/organisation.

*Full evaluation includes two tests: Body Difficulty (without or with apparatus) and Apparatus Difficulty.

How to participate:

- All the BD have to be performed by each gymnast only once, one BD after another, free hand (without apparatus) in the following order: Balances, Rotations, Jumps/Leaps (min one of each group, max indicated within the table below)
- Number of BD indicated per each age category.
- Choose BD that the gymnast can perform well, Level A should present BD with the value 0.3 and above, Level B should present any value of BD, Level C has a limited BD value from 0,1–0,3.
- Video recording has to be submitted and will be evaluated by the judges for the difficulty and execution(technical faults), as per FIG RG COP 2017-2020).

Evaluation details:

- Judges evaluate technical faults: small 0.1, medium 0.2-0.3, large 0.5 or more. If there is an execution fault of 0.5 or more, BD is not counted, the fault deduction applies.
- All balances performed on a flat foot have -0.1 in value (example balance with the
 value 0.4 performed on a flat foot will be counted as 0.3). The final score: sum of
 technical deductions is subtracted from 10.00 points and Difficulty value added (an
 example below).

• Kesuns and Recommendations: DD performed with no deductions or small U₁ raunt proves to be a good choice for the routines, and indicates a high level of the execution by a gymnast. Deduction of 0,3 indicates that BD needs an additional work. BD with a deduction 0,5 or more should not be included in a routine at this stage and needs a lot of work before approving it for the routines.

Video requirements:

- The recording must be in a HORIZONTAL format
- Side balances should be recorded with the gymnast facing the camera, other balances and jumps – sidewise to the camera. Rotations can start facing front or sidewise.
- No other individuals in the recording, except the gymnast. No extraneous noises, comments, effects, inscriptions and other sounds are permitted.
- Action sequence should be recorded in a single take for all the BD one after another
- No edits to the video or audio recordina
- Camera must be stabilised
- · High video resolution of the recording is required with clear view of the gymnast
- Recording has to be done in the area permitting the safe execution and clear view(preferably in a gym hall)
- Gymnast appearance requirements: Leotard, Half-shoes, Bun
