5. NATIONA FLAG AND ANTHEM

Delegations are requested to bring a CD of their national anthem and their national flag (approx. size 180 cm x 90 cm). These must be handed to the OC Secretariat by the head of delegation upon arrival at the time of accreditation.

6. OPENING CEREMONY

Openning ceremony will be held at 09:45 on May 14. The opening ceremony will take about 15 minutes.

7. OFFICIAL LANGUAGE

The official language of the World Cup is English. Announcements will be made in Chinese and English only.

8.ACCREDITATION AND ID CARDS

All delegation members will receive an accreditation ID Card. The accreditation ID Card is personal, non transferable and compulsory to get access to the training and competition hall, functions, and the bus system. All participants and officials are required to wear the ID Cards at all times.

Accreditation will take place at the informaion desk upon arrival.

During accreditation, heads of delegation must check the correct names of their delegation, verify accommodation requirements, complete any necessary payments, hand in their national anthem and national flag, and provide their confirmation of insurance. Age control will be completed by Secretariat at the arrival moment.

As far as the number of accreditations per country is concerned, the FIG Rules and the Directives will be strictly applied.

9.TRANSPORTATION

The Organizing Committee will provide shuttle bus transportation between hotel and competition venue between May 11 and 15 for training and competition. A detailed schedule will be posted at the Lobby of hotel and the Competition Venue.

10.MEALS

For all participants who have paid meal costs, Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner will be served at their own respective hotel. Voucher must be needed for meals. Detailed schedule will be posted at the Lobby of hotel as follows:

12. ORIENTATION MEETING

Orientation Meeting will be held on Friday May 13, 2016 at 10:30. It will take place on the 1st floor in Royalton Hotel(next door to the venue). All Heads of Delegation must attend the meeting. One extra official per delegation may also attend. The FIG Technical Delegate and the OC will provide detailed information regarding the competition. All information will be in English only. After orientation meeting, the official reception will be held on the 2nd floor of Royalton Hotel.

13. MEDAL AWARD CEREMONIES

Only the medal winners are invited to participate and must appear in competition attire.

14. EQUIPMENT

Trampoline: 4 Gymnova Trampolines with 4x5 mm beds

Tumbling: 1 Acrosport Tumbling track

15. TRAINING - WARM UP

Training sessions will start on Thursday May 11 at 09.30 in both the Competition and Training Halls following the enclosed schedule. In case of any change, an updated version will be provided upon arrival of each delegation.

16. STARTING ORDER – DRAWING OF LOTS

The draw for qualifications' starting order took place in Lausanne on April 28,2016. The starting order can be also found as an attachment to this work plan. In case of any change, an updated version will be provided upon arrival.

Starting order for the finals will be in the order of merit, according to FIG Rules. The list of finalists and the two reserves will be distributed to the Heads of Delegation after the qualifications.

Please note: The World Cup Competition draw, the competition groups, the starting lists, the training groups, the training schedule and the competition schedule are based on the assumption that all registered federations will participate in accordance with their definitive registrations. Should there be any changes to participating numbers at the time of the competition, the FIG Technical Delegate in consultation with the Organising Committee reserve the right to make adjustments, which will facilitate the smooth running of the competition.

17. COMPETITION CARDS

All competition cards for Qualification and finals must be handed back to organziers at the information desk in the competition venue **before Friday May 13 until 10:00.**

All competition cards for Finals must be handed back to organziers at the information desk in the competition venue <u>before Sunday May 15 until 10:00.</u>

18.JUDGES' DRAW AND INSTRUCTION

Judges' meeting, which is compulsory for all judges, will take place on Friday May 13 in the Judges' Meeting Room in the competition venue, to be held in English only.

- Trampoline Friday, May 13 15:00-16:00 1st floor of the venue
- Tumbling Friday, July 1 16:00-16:30 1st floor of the venue

The composition of the panels for the finals will be decided by the FIG Technical Delegate. It will be published at least two hours prior to the beginning of the final.

19.SUPERIOR JURY AND JURY OF APPEAL

Technical delegate will act as president of this superior jury.

20. SCORES AND RESULTS

Scores of the juries and the final results will be shown on the electronic score boards in the competition hall.

A detailed list of results will be distributed to the Heads of Delegation after the qualifications and the finals. At the end of the competition each delegation will receive a CD with all results.

21. VIDEO RECORDING

All routines will be recorded on video by the OC.

22. SEATING FOR THE DELEGATIONS

Sections in the competition hall are reserved for all delegation members, and all delegation members must take a seat in this area.

23. MEDICAL SERVICES AND MASSAGE

Medical services will be provided by the Medical authorities located at the Venue. Massage facilities for accompanying masseurs of the delegations are available in the training hall.

24. CLOSING BANQUET

There will be a closing banquet in a ship on Huangpu River at 20:00 on May 15, 2016. During the dinner, the results, flags and anthems will be distributed to all delegations.

The banquet is for official delegation members only, and a valid banquet ticket must be presented at the entrance.

The shuttle bus will depart from respective hotel at 18:50 on May 15, please remind all team members to be punctual.

25. INFORMATION AND CORRESPONDENCE DURING COMPETITION

Every delegation will have a mailbox located at the OC Secretariat in the Venue. Access to the mailbox is only provided for those holding a Head of Delegation accreditation ID Card. A signature will be required for each delivery.
