REGISTRATION AND ACCREDITATION

Along with the Nominative Registration (to be sent on September 28, 2017, at the latest) all Federations must send a copy of the passport and a photograph (with member's info on file) for each member of the delegation. It must be sent via email to: inscripciones@fedecolgim.co

Photographs must comply with the following characteristics:

- JPEG format
- Size: 45mm x 35mm
- With member's info on file to avoid confusions with accreditations:
 Example:

"COUNTRY_ FUNCTION_CATEGORY_ LAST NAME_NAME" PER GYMNAST GROUP ORJEDA JUANA

In case accreditation is stolen or lost, LOC must be informed as soon as possible to cancel it. The replacement fee will be USD\$10.00.

Participants must wear accreditations at all times for the duration of the event.

Accreditations will be distributed upon arrival at the Registration Desk.

During registration, the Heads of Delegation must present the following files:

- Passport from each of the delegation members
- Medical insurance from all the delegation members
- Music on MP3 format with proper labels containing athlete information Example: PER_SENIOR_IW_PEREZ_Juana
- 1 CD or USB drive per track per routine
- National Anthem
- Country flag
- List of elements of difficulty
- FIG License

EVENT FORMAT

The Pan American Championship consists of two stages: qualifying round and finals, in all categories and age groups.

Qualifiers

A maximum of 4 gymnasts/units are allowed to participate per Federation on each category and age group.

Finals

Eight (8) best scores will qualify to finals per category and age group (maximum 2 per Federation).

In case of any tie that cannot be broken, a second draw will be carried out for the tied places, right after the qualification competition.

If the Organizing Federation failed to qualify in any category or age group whatsoever, it may have a "wild card" with a gymnast/unit in the category they choose on that specific age group, provided they participated during the qualifying round.

Therefore, the maximum amount of gymnasts/units during Finals is 8+1 in one category and 8 gymnasts/units on the remaining categories.

The gymnast/unit with the "wild card" may be awarded a medal.

Team Ranking (in each age group)

In order to participate on Team Ranking, Federations must be represented by at least one unit during the qualifying round.

- Aerobic Gymnastics: Individual Men's and/or Individual Women's, Mixed Pairs, Trio, Group
- Aero Dance

Team ranking will be established by the addition of the top 4 places as follows:

- top 3 out of 4 places on Aerobic Gymnastics: Individual Men's or Individual Women's, Mixed Pairs, Trio, Group
- best placement on Aero Dance

The top 4 places from each Team will turn into points according to their placement during Qualifications; for example, 1º place = 1 point, 2º place = 2 points, etc.

The Federation with the least amount of points will be declared Pan American Team Champion.

Medals will be awarded to the best placement on every category registered for Team Ranking, even if they failed to contribute points to the final Team sum.

Delegations must notify their team composition (1 Individual Men's and/or Individual Women's, 1 Mixed Pair, 1 Trio, 1 Group, 1 Aero Dance) at the moment of Nominative registration.

	This request must include member's function, full name, gender, date of birth, citizenship, passport number, passport's expiration date, arrival and departure dates, as well as the city where the official invitation letter is to be sent.		
INSURANCE	The Host Federation, the Organizing Committee and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and the like. The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.		
	The LOC will verify the insurance upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy). Delegation members with insufficient insurance cover must inform the LOC in advance. This must cover the complete duration of the event. All the members of the delegation, including officials (coaches, judges, team managers, medical staff and head of delegation) whose insurance does not cover the full event will not be allowed to take part on the event. LOC will offer insurance to Federations for USD\$20.00 per person per		
INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION	Participant delegations must pay the international travelling expenses of all their members. International Airport: El Dorado International Airport (BOG) Airport to hotel transportation will only be provided to the delegations that booked their trip through official packages of accommodation. Transportation will only be provided to official hotels for delegations arriving on Wednesday, October 25 and vice versa, for the delegations departing on Monday, October 30 (except for PAGU's Technical Delegate and representatives). Reservations must be done through Local Organizing Committee.

Delegations who do not book their accommodation on the hotel through the Local Organizing Committee, will not have access to local transportation (airport-hotel-airport or hotel-gymnasium-hotel) and will have to pay their ticket for the farewell party.

100% of the accommodation/meal expenses must be paid to LOC by the time of the Nominative Registration. There will be no refunds on cancellations.

Prices charged for rooms will not exceed the usual fares of the hotel and will only be considered for the official dates of the event.

The Nominative Registration Form must be sent to the Organizing Committee on September 28, 2017, at the latest. Rooms will be distributed following the order in which requests are received.

Participant delegations must pay for accommodation and/or meals expenses of every member of their delegation.

CANCELLATION POLICY FAREWELL PARTY

Keep in mind that there will be **no refunds** on cancellations.

The farewell party will be held on Sunday, October 29, 2017 and will not have an additional cost to participant delegation members who stayed at the official hotels and to those who paid for an additional accreditation.
