	Category A and B tournaments must offer a Final in all 5 categories.

	• In addition, if the Organizing Member Federation has not qualified in any category, it may nominate one participation in max. 1 category of its choice.			
	• Maximum participation in the finals is therefore 8+1 participants in one category and 8 in the other four categories.
