	invitation letter, provided that the request is made before September 30 <sup>th</sup> to the LOC.			
	The request must include the function, full name, gender, date of birth, citizenship and passport number, passport expiry date, the arrival and departure dates of the Delegation Member as well as the city the visa application support letter must be sent to.			
INSURANCE	The Host Federation, the LOC and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and the like.			
	The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.			
	The LOC will verify the insurance upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy).			
	Delegation members with insufficient insurance cover must inform the LOC in advance. The LOC will subsequently offer insurance at the Federations own charge. Price per person/day will be fixed by the French federation as follows:			
	5 € per person/day for illness and medical fees			
	6 € per person/day for illness, medical fees and repatriation			
	Please ask FFG for details.			
INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION	The invited participating federations must pay for the travel costs of their delegation members, but up to 600 Euros of the travel international and local expenses will be refunded for a delegation composed of 6 persons (100 Euros maximum by person) on presentation of proof of transport.			
	The Travel Schedule Form must be returned to the LOC by October 15 <sup>th</sup>			
LOCAL	Local transportation facilities will be provided by the local LOC.			
TRANSPORTATION	On request, the LOC will pick up the delegations at the airport and a shuttle system will operate between the hotel and the sport hall.
