VISA

Please verify immediately with your travel agent or the Canadian Embassy or Consulate in your country if a visa is required for your travel to Canada. The Organizing Committee will be happy to assist each Delegation member with an official invitation letter, provided that the request is made before April 1st, 2017 to the LOC.

The request must include the function, full name, gender, date of birth, citizenship and passport number, passport expiry date, the arrival and departure dates of the Delegation Member as well as the city the visa application support letter must be sent to.

ELECTRONIC TRAVEL AUTHORIZATION

NEW CANADIAN IMMIGRATION LAWS

As of November 9th, 2016 all visa-exempt foreign nationals who fly to or transit through Canada will need an **Electronic Travel Authorization (eTA)**. Exceptions include U.S. citizens and travelers with a valid Canadian visa. Canadian citizens, including dual citizens, and Canadian permanent residents do not need to apply for an eTA.

To apply you must have a valid passport, a credit card and an email address. It costs \$7 CAD and only takes a few minutes to apply. Approved eTAs are valid for 5 years or until your passport expires, whichever comes first.

INSURANCE

The Host Federation, the Organizing Committee and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and the like.

The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation (except for gymnasts and judges).

The LOC will verify the insurance upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy). Delegation members with insufficient insurance cover must inform the LOC in advance.

INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION

The invited participating federations must pay for the travel costs of their delegation members (see exception herein below).
