In addition, the Organising Member Federation may participate in the finals with one group (the best group in the competition) at its free choice. This Wild Card group will have to start first. 				
INVITED CLUBS, ASSOCIATIONS AND FEDERATIONS	The participation is open to all Representatives of National Federations, District or Regional Associations as well as affiliated clubs in the respective Federations.				
	All national teams, associations and clubs in good standing are entitled to participate, with unlimited gymnasts and groups.				
SIZE OF DELEGATIONS AND LICENSES	Only gymnasts in good standing with the correct age and holding a valid FIG License until the end of the event may participate.				
	The Local Organizing Committee will be responsible for checking the validity of the gymnasts Licenses. No gymnast will be accepted without a valid FIG License at the time of the event. The maximum size of the invited delegation is as follows:

	The request must include the function, full name, gender, date of birth, citizenship and passport number, passport expiry date, the arrival and departure dates of the Delegation Member as well as the city the visa application support letter must be sent to.			
INSURANCE	The Host Federation, the LOC and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and the like. The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.			
	The LOC will verify the insurance upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or copy of the valid policy). English version is compulsory. Delegation members with insufficient insurance cover must inform the LOC in advance. The LOC will subsequently offer insurance at the Federations own charge as follows: 35EUR per person/day.
