

The MGA was officially opened in April 2014. This gymnastics specialized Arena has already hosted the 30th Rhythmic Gymnastics European Championships (June 13-15, 2014), the 1st WTF World Cadet Taekwondo Championships (July 24-27, 2014), as well as 2015 NN Table Tennis Club ITTF-Europe Top 16 CUP" (February 6-8), Open Joint Azerbaijan Championships in Gymnastics Disciplines (held as a Test Event for the 1st European Games, March 4-6, 2015) and Competitions in 6 Gymnastics Disciplines of the 1st European Games (June 14-21, 2015). The Arena has the ability to stretch from 5,000 to 9,600 seats, depending on the size and the nature of the event it hosts.

During the given World Cup, Training and warm-up facilities will be located within the MGA.

PARTICIPATION

The World Cup competition will consist of Qualifications and Finals.

Participation in the Qualifications:

- All competitors must take part in the qualifications.
- No qualifications must be held if there are less than 9 participants per disciplines.
- In case of a tie at any place, the tie-breaking rules as set up for the World Championships shall be applied. Nevertheless the gymnasts not qualified for the finals and with the same final score will receive the same world cup points.

Participation in the Finals:

- The top eight gymnasts or pairs from the qualifications qualify for the finals.
- Max. 2 individuals or 1 pair per NF per discipline.
- In addition, the host federation will be allowed one man or one woman in Trampoline Individual, 1 Pair (male or female) in TRA Synchro, in case that it is not represented at all in Trampoline Ind, Trampoline Synchro.
- Such "Wild Card Gymnasts or Pairs" must have participated in the qualification.
- "Wild Card Gymnasts" will receive medals and prize money, but they will not receive any World Cup Points.
- In case of a tie at any place, the tie-breaking rules as set up for the World Championships shall be applied.

World Cup Competitions may exceptionally be combined with other Competition.

Cancellation Policy

- The <u>organizing member Federation (LOC)</u> may cancel the competition in the respective category if at the time of the definitive entry there are less than 4 countries registered in a category. In case of such a cancellation, the LOC must reimburse, in full, the entry fee and payments made for accommodation. Should flights have to be cancelled due to the above, the risk is at the charge of the participating member Federations (NF).
- The participating member Federations (NF) may cancel its participation in a specific category without any penalty or payment for fees, accommodation and meals already booked, in case of less than 4 participating countries in that category after the definitive deadlines.
- Procedure and deadlines for the cancellation of a category by the LOC or participation by the NF is as follows:
- o FIG shall inform LOC and NF about the participation, within 5 days after the Definitive registration deadline.
- LOC and NF have the possibility to cancel the event (in a specific category) respectively their participation within 5 days after information by the FIG. Such notification must be sent by e-mail or fax to the FIG. Cancellations after this deadline will not be accepted.

"HORS CONCOURS" GYMNASTS

The Organizing Member Federation is allowed to add only for the qualifications "hors concours" competitors. These competitors are in addition to the official participants of the Organizing Member Federation's competitors, they must be named before the start of the qualifications and cannot qualify for the final. They will have to start first.

The Organizing Member Federation is allowed to name 2 Individual Men and 2 individual Women, as well as 1 Synhro pair Men and 1 Synchro pair Women as hors concours" competitors.

FEDERATIONS INVITED

The Organizing Member Federation invites all FIG Member Federations who have paid their annual membership fee for Trampoline Gymnastics.

SIZE OF DELEGATION AND FIG LICENCE

Only senior gymnasts in good standing with the correct age and holding a valid FIG License may participate. The Organizing Committee will be responsible for checking the validity of the gymnast' Licenses. No gymnasts will be accepted without a valid FIG License at the deadline of the Nominative Registration. The maximum size of the invited delegation is as follows:

Out of competition gymnasts will not be accepted.

AGE LIMITS

Participating gymnasts must be at least 17 years (born in 1999 or before) in all disciplines.

Note: gymnasts who have participated in a Senior World Championships, Senior Continental Championships or World Cup competitions may not

participate in Junior competitions afterwards. **JUDGES AND** The number of Judges' panels may be decided by the organizing member **JURIES** federation depending on the number of participating competitors and judges. The Judges' panels will be set up by a draw - directed by the FIG Technical Delegate – from the judges present at the event. Each participating federation must provide minimum one judge (minimum category III) per discipline in which they participate. Failure to do so will result in a fine of CHF 2'000.- to be paid to the organizing member federation. The organizing federation is responsible that there are enough FIG brevetted judges present with the appropriate category of brevet for their function (minimum category III). Only the citizens of the countries where there is no Embassy of Azerbaijan will be issued a visa upon their arrival at Heydar Aliyev International Airport. If this is the case, the OC will send the Federations concerned authorization from the Migration Service of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Azerbaijan Republic enabling them to get their visas at the airport, provided that the request is made in due time.

The request must include the function, full name, gender and other passport details, the arrival and departure dates of the Delegation Member as well as the city the visa application support letter must be sent to. In addition, the online system will require upload of passport copy for each member of the delegation.

INSURANCE

The Host Federation, the LOC and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and the like. The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation. The LOC will verify the insurance upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy). Delegation members with insufficient insurance cover must inform the LOC in advance. The LOC will subsequently offer insurance at the Federations own charge as follows: EUR 20.- per person.

ACCREDITATION

Accreditation cards will be distributed at the Accreditation Centre situated at the Competition Venue upon arrival of the delegations.

The following items will be checked there with the Heads of delegations:

- The passport of gymnasts and judges including all members of the delegations
- Transport Departure
- The medical insurance for the members of the delegations
- 2 copies of competition cards for each gymnast/synchro pair
- National anthem and national flag

In order to accelerate the process of the accreditation, each participating Federation is kindly requested to upload photos and passport copy of each member of its delegation (gymnasts, head of delegation, team manager, judges, coaches, medical staff and etc.) into the LOC's online program in the following link via Azerbaijan Gymnastics Federation's website: registration.agf.az

The deadline for the photos & passport copies upload (identity colour photo in JPG format, size – 45mm x 35mm, resolution: 800x600plx) is **February 4**, **2016**. Please clearly indicate the corresponding full name (with correct spelling) in the file title.

Sending of photos in due time will prevent the delegations from waiting at the accreditation centre.

FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS
