Qualifications and Finals Qualification: The 5th Aerobic Asian Championships is opened for AG1, AG2 with categories: IM, IW, MP, TR, GR and Senior with categories: IM, IW, MP, TR, GR, AD, AS. Qualification for the Senior is opened for maximum two units from each Federation thus a participation of two units per category. The finals are opened for 2 units per country only. 2. Prize Money Prize money as mentioned under PRIZE MONEY will be paid to the top three per category 3. Award Ceremonies Only one award ceremony (per category) will be held based on the 5th Asian Aerobic Gymnastics Ranking List. 4. Registration All competitors may only be registered by their respective AGU member Federations, using the official registration forms. See also REGISTRATION DEADLINE **FEDERATION INVITED** All AGU Member Federation is Asia continent who have paid their annual membership fee for Aerobic Gymnastics as well as AGU membership fee. With an official letter of request to the AGU HQ, AUS and NZL are given the opportunity to participate but will not be entitled for the medals and no prize money. **PARTICIPATION** Categories: AG1, AG2 (IM, IW, MP, TR, GR) and Senior (IM, IW, MP, TR, GR, AD, AS) Participation is as below. Based on FIG International Events Rules, Art.2 & 3, "All gymnasts (including Age Group) must have FIG License to participate". The Local Organizing Committee will be responsible for checking the validity of the gymnast Licenses. No gymnast will be accepted without a valid FIG License at the deadline of the Registration. 	A jury must consist of 1 Chair of Judges Panel, 4 Artistic, 4 Execution and 2 Difficult judges.				
	A federation may not have a judge on both the execution and artistic panels. The Chair of Judges Panel and the difficulty judges should also be from different federations.				
	The CJP must be of Category 1. The Difficult Judges must be Category 1 or 2 The Execution and Artistic judges must be Category 1, 2, 3 or 4.				
	If, on the day of the competition, there is not sufficient number of judges in the requested categories, the Technical Delegate may take whatever action needed to secure the running of the event.				
	Each participation federation must provide minimum one judge. If the federation provides two judges, then one judge is preferred to be Category 3 and above if possible. Failure to do so will result in a fine of US \$1,000 to be paid to the Organizing Federation; exception can be made by the Local Organizing Committee.				
	The Organizing Federation is responsible that there is enough FIG brevetted judges present with the appropriate category of brevet for their function.
