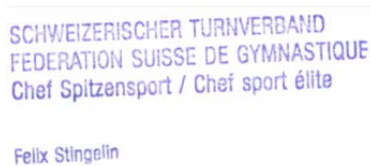

The request must include the function, full name, gender, date of birth, citizenship and passport number, passport expiry date, the arrival and departure dates of the Delegation Member as well as the city the visa application support letter must be sent to.	
INSURANCE	The Host Federation, the Organizing Committee and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and the like. The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.	
INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION	Travel expenses for registered delegations are paid by the OC . The registered delegations have to send travel proposals (including prices) to the OC. After receiving the confirmation of the OC, the flight or train ticket has to be booked by the respective national Federation. Reimbursement of travel costs: For the reimbursement the national Federations have to send after the definitive booking an invoice of the travel costs to the Department of sport elite of the Swiss Gymnastics Federation.
