FORMAT	 Qualifications Team Final and Individual Qualifications A team may consist of three or four gymnasts and each gymnast may, subject to compliance with the following requirement, perform one to four exercises (maximum). The competition programme comprises exercises using the following apparatus as prescribed; hoop, ball, clubs, ribbon. Each team must perform three exercises on each apparatus, by different gymnasts, making a total of 12 exercises. The team classification is made by adding the 10 best scores registered by the gymnasts of the team. 			
	 Individual All-Around Final To be qualified for the All-Around Final, gymnasts must compete on 3 – 4 apparatus in Qualifications, the classification is made by adding the 3 best scores obtained. The 15 best gymnasts from qualification participate to the individual All-Around Final, taking into account a maximum limit of two gymnasts per Enderation 			
	Federation. The programme consists of four exercises with the prescribed apparatus and the classification is made by adding the four scores obtained with the four apparatus. No consideration is taken of the results of team final and Individual all-around qualification competition.
