ACCREDITATIONS

Between the nominative registrations all federations shall send a valid copy of the Passport and a photography white background of all members of the delegations: officials and extra-officials. Each photo should fulfill the following requirements:

- File format: jpeg
- Dimensions: min. 210 X 270 pixels, max. 420 X 540 pixels
- Width 35 x 45 height
- File size: not bigger than 1MB

Each file should be identified with the country and name of each member. Ex. COUNTRY-Name-Last Name.

These documents should be sent to the LOC until **20 August 2017.**Photo take at the host city will have additional cost of USD\$100.00 each.
Accreditation costs for additional people (coaches, team managers, doctor, physiatrist and reserve junior gymnast) will be USD\$100.00 each. This accreditation entitled to enter areas allowed under the function, internal transportation and farewell banquet.

The payment of the additional accreditation must be to LOC by **20 August 2017**, by international transfer.

In case of lost or stolen accreditation, the LOC must be informed immediately to block the accreditation. Lost or stolen accreditations may be replaced at the charge of the card holder USD\$50.00.

EVENT FORMAT

The CoP RG 2017-2020 will be used, and will apply all the modifications and updates to date.

TEAM COMPETITION

A team can consist of 3 to 4 gymnasts for a total of 10 exercises. As indicated the following table.

Each gymnast can only perform one exercise per apparatus. The team classification is obtained by the addition of the 8 highest marks obtained by the team gymnasts.

INDIVIDUAL COMPETITION

For gymnasts who participate in the qualifications as individuals, the program consists of 3 or 4 exercises performed with the official apparatus. Their classification determines the qualification for the final of the individual multiple competition that is obtained by the addition of the 3 highest scores, and for the Finals per apparatus according to the score obtained in the apparatus in question. The gymnasts participating in the team competition may also qualify for the final of the individual multiple competition by adding their highest 3 scores and for the Finals per apparatus according to the score obtained on the apparatus in question. All gymnasts (maximum 2 per National Federation) who have participated in the apparatus concerned have the possibility to qualify to participate in


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the final of the individual multiple contest and the final per apparatus.

A. INDIVIDUAL MULTIPLE COMPETITIONS

Only participates the 10 best gymnasts of the qualifications taking into account the maximum limit of 2 gymnasts by National Federation. Two reserve gymnasts are designated taking into consideration the list of results. The so-called reserve gymnasts will compete according to the order of passage of the gymnasts they replace. Reserve gymnasts must be ready in case they are called to compete

The program consists of four exercises, using respectively the four official apparatus. The classification is obtained by adding the four notes in the four apparatus, without taking into account the results of the qualification



The gymnast who has obtained the highest score in the sum of the notes of the four exercises will be proclaimed champion.

B. APPARATUS FINALS

The 8 best gymnasts (Maximum 2 per national federation) of the qualifications in each of the 4 apparatus of the program are designated to participate in the individual finals per apparatus. 2 reserve gymnasts are appointed on the basis of the qualifications. If they are called to compete, they will take the position of the gymnast to replace. Reserve gymnasts must be ready in case they are called to compete.

The gymnast who has the highest score in each apparatus will be proclaimed champion.

- Double room occupancy \$USD 70.00 per person per night.
- Additional person \$USD 100.00 per night.

Note: All reservations should be made through de LOC. Members of the delegations that do not stay at the official hotels shall not be awarded accreditations.

The accommodation form (numeral and nominative) should be fulfill and send to the LOC as follow:

- Name of 2 hotels of your preference numeral accommodations no later than 20 June 2017.
- Nominative form no later than 20 August 2017.

The rooms will be allocated strictly in order of booking receipt "first come, first serve", and base on each delegation size and hotel preferences.

It is requested to the Federations enlist 2 hotels in order of preference. If both options are no longer available, the LOC will contact directly with the federation to look for options.

To secure your preferred hotel, it is strongly recommended to send the accommodation form and transfer deposit well in advance of the due dates of 20 June 2017 and 20 August 2017 respectively.

Once Member Federations have send the accommodation form with their hotel preferences the LOC will send an email confirming receipt of the accommodations form. This email will also include the Member Federations invoice based on 50% of the total value of the delegations selected first choice accommodation. The reserve will only confirm once deposits are received. Please be advised that deposits are calculated on Member Federations first choice and this does not guarantee you will be allocated in your first preferred hotel. Should your Member Federation be allocated your second or third choice

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of accommodation the total deposit will be deducted of the final balance due.

Members' federations should pay all expenses of accommodations of all their member of delegations.

All costs of accommodations and meals should be paid to LOC as follows:

• 50% of the total amount no later than 20 July 2017

• Final 50% no later than 20 August 2017

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Failure to forward the payment by the required dates will result in the accommodation being cancelled and in the deposit payment being forfeited. CANCELLATION POLICY

Cancellations until 20 July 2017 at very latest will be subject to a cancellation fee of 0%

Cancellations from 21 July until 20 August 2017 at the very latest will be subject to a cancellation fee of 50% to be paid by the Federation concerned. Therefore Member Federations will not have their deposits returned.

Cancellations from 21 August until 10 September 2017 at the very latest will be subject to a cancellation fee of 75% to be paid by the Federation concerned. Cancellations from 11 September until the arrival of the delegations on site or "no show" will be subject to a cancellation fee of 100% to be paid by the Federation.

Accredited delegations members, will receive a free ticket for the Farewell Banquet.
