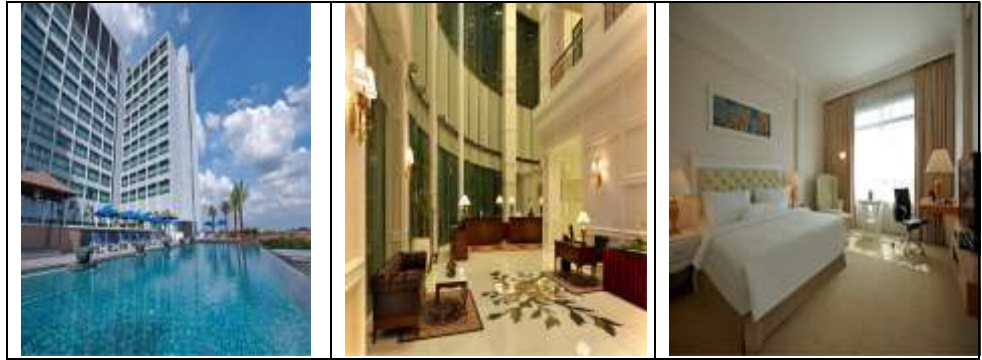

FEDERATIONS INVITED	<p>The Organizing Member Federation will invite all AGU Member Federations in good standing.</p> <p>Federations which have not fulfilled their annual membership fees towards the AGU and FIG and not fulfilled their financial obligations towards the Organising Committee will not be allowed to participate in the Asian Championships.</p>
AGE LIMITS	<p>Seniors 16 years (born in 2002 or before) in the year of the competition</p>
FIG LICENSE	<p>All gymnasts must have a current valid FIG licence until the end of the event.</p>
COMPETITION EVENTS	<p>Individuals</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Qualifying Individual Competition with Team ranking - All-Around Final: - Apparatus Finals: <p>Group competitions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - General Competition and Qualifications - Group Finals
COMPETITION FORMAT	<p>Individual:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Qualifications <p><i>Team Final and Individual Qualifications</i></p> <p>A team may consist of three or four gymnasts and each gymnast may, subject to compliance with the following requirement, perform one to four exercises (maximum).</p> <p>The competition programme comprises exercises using the following apparatus as prescribed; hoop, ball, clubs, ribbon.</p> <p>Each team must perform three exercises on each apparatus, by different gymnasts, making a total of 12 exercises.</p> <p>The team classification is made by adding the 10 best scores registered by the gymnasts of the team.</p> <p>- <i>Individual All-Around Final</i></p> <p>To be qualified for the All-Around Final, gymnasts must compete on 3 – 4 apparatus in Qualifications, the classification is made by adding the 3 best scores obtained.</p> <p>The 15 best gymnasts from qualification participate to the individual All-Around Final, taking into account a maximum limit of two gymnasts per Federation.</p> <p>The programme consists of four exercises with the prescribed apparatus and the classification is made by adding the four scores obtained with the four apparatus. No consideration is taken of the results of team final and Individual all-around qualification competition.</p> <p>- <i>Apparatus Finals</i></p> <p>The best 8 gymnasts (maximum of 2 per Federation) on each of the 4 apparatus in Qualifications shall qualify to participate in the Individual apparatus finals.</p> <p>Group:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Qualification and All Around: <p>The programme for Groups competition in All-Around will be determined by the sum of two exercises (5 hoops, 3 balls + 2 ropes).</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Apparatus Finals <p>In Final competitions will perform 8 best groups in each exercise by the result of performance in the competitions of All-round.</p>

INSURANCE	<p>The Host Federation, the LOC and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and the like. The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.</p> <p>The LOC will verify the insurance upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy). Delegation members with insufficient insurance cover must inform the LOC in advance.</p> <p>The LOC will subsequently offer insurance at the Federation own charge as follows: 10 USD per person/day.</p>

- Passports of all members of the delegation;
- CD with the national anthem and the national flag;
- 2 copies of CDs with music for the programs (each gymnast and group)
- Air tickets of all members of the delegation;
- Licence of each gymnast;
- Certification of insurance for all delegation members covering illness, accidents, repatriation.

In order to speed accreditation procedures, please send to the Organizing Committee a photo of each member of the delegation (in electronic format or passport photo) together with the nominative registration (30 April 2018).

If the photo has to be taken at the Accreditation because none has been sent within the deadline or not sent in the official requested format, there will be a charge of USD 10 for each photo taken at the accreditation desk.
