This competition is organized by a rotation of groups. A group comprises a team of up to 5 gymnasts entered by national federations or mixed teams consisting of individual gymnasts of different federations.		
	Qualification: Not more than 4 gymnasts of each team compete on any single apparatus and the 3 highest scores are taken into account for the team total (5 – 4 – 3 system).		
	Finals: The 6 teams having obtained the highest total scores in the qualification take part in the finals. Not more than 2 gymnasts of each team compete on any single apparatus and both scores are taken into account for the team total (5 – 2 – 2 system).		
PLANNED COMPETITION FORMAT WAG	We offer a team competition for WAG with qualification and finals. For WAG the competition consists of optional exercises on four apparatuses (only one vault). This competition is organized by a rotation of groups. A group comprises a team of up to 5 gymnasts entered by national federations or mixed teams consisting of individual gymnasts of different federations.		
	Qualification: Not more than 4 gymnasts of each team compete on any single apparatus and the 3 highest scores are taken into account for the team total (5 – 4 – 3 system).		
	Finals: The 4 teams having obtained the highest total scores in the qualification take part in the finals. Not more than 3 gymnasts of each team compete on any single apparatus and all three scores are taken into account for the team total (5 – 3 – 3 system).

ENTRY FEES

No entry fee will be applied for this event.

TIE BREAKING RULES

Qualification:

In case of a tie in points at any place in qualification, the ranking will be determined by the following criteria:

- 1. The team with the highest sum of the team apparatus counting scores obtained will prevail (i.e. the total of 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 highest apparatus team scores for men and the total of 3, 2, 1 highest apparatus team scores for women)
- 2. If they remain tied the teams will share the same classification

Final:

In case of a tie at any place the tie will not be broken. The prize money of the tied ranks will be added and divided by the number of ties.

ACCOMMODATION

The Organizing Committee will offer three different hotel categories, one of them being a first class hotel next to the competition venue (Cat.1; Hilton Garden Inn, in walking distance to the venue), one mid class (Cat.2; Hotel Europe) and one "low-cost hotel" (Cat.3; e.g. Hotel B&B),.

Prices for hotels are not determined yet. The price range per room will be approx.:

- Free transportation from the Stuttgart airport or railway station to the hotel and back/ free transportation from hotel to the competition venue and back.

The prices charged for the hotel rooms will not exceed the usual hotel rates. While the Accommodation Form must be returned to the LOC by **18 January 2017** at the very latest, the hotel rooms will be allocated on a "first come, first serve" basis. 	After the Definitive Registration you will get an invoice stating the accommodation costs. At the 1 February 2017 they are due. Entries without the payment of the accommodation costs will be considered invalid and will be refused Cancellation policy: The whole amount will be refunded for cancellations submitted before 1 February 2017 . For any partial or total cancellation after the 1 February 2017 , no money will be refunded.	
MEALS	All delegations have to pay for their own meals apart from breakfast, which is included in the accommodation price.	
FINAL BANQUET	A final banquet will be held on Sunday, 19 March 2017. Entrance is free for all delegation members.	
INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION	The members of the invited participating federations must pay for their international transportation.	
LOCAL TRANSPORTATION	Local transportation between Stuttgart airport/train station and the hotels and between the hotels and the competition venue will be provided by the LOC for all delegation members except for the hotels in walking distance. However, local transportation free of charge will be provided only for delegations that have booked their accommodation via the LOC. VISA	Please verify immediately with your travel agent or the German Embassy or Consulate in your country, if a visa is required for your travel to Germany. The Organizing Committee will be happy to assist each Delegation member with an official invitation letter, provided that the request is made to the LOC before 18 February 2017. Please find the Visa Request Form on the event website: www.enbw-dtbpokal.de The request must include the function, full name, gender, date of birth, citizenship and passport number, passport expiry date, the arrival and departure dates of the delegation member as well as the city the visa application support letter must be sent to. INSURANCE	a copy via email for free if that meets the requirement of your country. The Host Federation, the Organizing Committee and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and the like. The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their delegation. The LOC will verify the insurance upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy). Delegation members with insufficient insurance cover must inform the LOC in advance. The LOC will subsequently offer insurance at the Federation's charge as follows: 5 EUR per person/ per day.
