Age Limits	Juniors: born in 2003, 2004, 2005 Seniors: born in 2002 and older All gymnasts must have a FIG licence valid until the end of the event.					
Judges	All participating judges must have a valid FIG Brevet (cat. I, II, III, IV), for cycle 2017-2020, for the respective discipline (RGI and/or RGG). The participating Member Federations must send minimum one qualified judge as mentioned above. Failure to do so will result a fine of 150,00€ - to be paid to the LOC upon arrival.					
Entry Fee	The non-reimbursable entry Fee is: 40,00€ per Individual Gymnast 80,00€ per Group 30,00€ per each team member who does not choose to book accommodation through the LOC.					
Drawing of lots	Two weeks before the competition starts.

The costs for the accommodation must be paid to the LOC as follows: 50% until January 16th, 2018 and the rest 50% until February 16th, 2018.</p> <p>Please notify the LOC for your choice on the hotel class when your provisional registration is made.</p> <p>Cancellation/Reimbursement Policy: 50% of accommodation costs are refundable provided cancellations are made at least 1 month prior to arrival. For cancellations made after February 16th, 2018 there will be no reimbursement.</p>

The request must include the function, full name, gender, date of birth, citizenship and passport number, passport expiry date, arrival and departure dates of the Delegation Members as well as the city the visa application support letter must be sent to.</p>
