INSURANCE	It is required that the Heads of Delegation present a medical insurance of every member of their delegation; otherwise, they will have to pay a medical insurance when they arrive, for the days of training and competition, whose cost is 45 USD per person. The Host Federation, the Organizing Committee, PAGU and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and		
	the like. The FIG Technical Regulations (Section 1, Article 12.10) foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the Members of their Delegation.		
	The LOC will verify the insurance upon the arrival of the members of each delegation (for example: the original and photocopy of the valid insurance policy). The Peruvian Federation of Gymnastics declines all responsibility in case of illness, accidents, and repatriation. Every participant must be insured against these risks.		
INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION	The invited participating federations must pay for the travel costs of their delegation members.		
	The Travel Schedule Form must be returned to the LOC by September 18th, 2016.		

LOCAL TRANSPORTATION	The LOC will provide ground transportation to the delegations from the International Airport of Lima to the Official Hotel and vice versa only if they arrive and depart on the date stipulated.			
	The LOC will provide also ground transportation from the hotel to the Gymnasium and vice versa for the days of training and competition.			
	If Delegations do not arrive or leave on the dates stipulated, The LOC can help arranging the transportation with an additional payment of USD20.00 per person per way. This must be paid at the moment of the registration.

AWARDS	A trophy will be awarded in each Age Categories (Senior, Age Group I and Age Group II) for the Federation having the greatest number in the sum of the four highest scores of 4 different categories: IM, IW, MP, TR, GR, AD (only for senior) and AS (only for Senior). Scores from qualification round will be used for team ranking.			
	Medals will be given to the first three places in each Age Categories, and in each of the discipline. Certificate of participation will be awarded to all competitors and officials. No prize money will be given.

RULES OF COMPETITION	The competition of the Pan-American Championship consists of a Qualifying Round and a Final Round in every category and age group.			

	 Qualifying Round: A maximum of 4 athletes per category and age group, per country. Final: Eight (8) gymnasts per category of the Qualifying Round will pass to the finals (Maximum, 2 per category, per country). If the organizing Federation has not qualified in any category, it will be able to appoint one participation, maximum: 1 per category, of its choice. Therefore, the Maximum Participation in the final phase is 8 + 1 in one category and 8 in the other 4 categories. The participant with the Wild Card must have participated in the respective qualifying categories, and he or she will be able to receive medals.
